GRAIN AND PRODUCE MARKET. Undertone in Wheat is Somewhat Stronger in the Pit. ARGENTINA SELLERS PLEASSED. Corn They Have Shipped to the United States and Canada Brings Them Better Prices Than They Expected.

OMAHA, Oct. 22. 1913. The undertone in wheat was a stronger one yesterday and while the price gains were only a few cents to reflect the bullish sentiment existing, they show that all the wheat that is grown upon the market around the present level will be absorbed by strong hands. It must be remembered that the wheat crop in Argentina and the short selling was on an enormous scale, and that there is a likelihood of a change coming with the latter in control for a time. In the absence of a break cash demand the bears seem to be ready to attack the market at any time.
