J., Aug. 27.—The United States Steel corporation today filed in the court of chancery an answer to the amended bill of complaint of J. Aspinwall Lodge, Bernard Smith and William C. Curtiss to restrain the proposed conversion of \$200,000,000 7 per cent preferred stock into \$200,000,000 5 per cent second mortgage bonds.

DIES FOR HIS CHICKENS' SAKE

MUSCATINE MAN HANGS HIMSELF BECAUSE NEIGHBOR WOULD CURE FEWELS TO BE COMBINED. MUSCATINE, Ia., Aug. 27.—(Special.)—Because his neighbor threatened to get out an injunction to make him keep his chickens at home, Herman J. Rauerdrinker, an old man of 72 years of age, committed suicide last evening by hanging himself from a rafter in a barn.
