TREASURY IS OUT OF GOLD For First Time in Years No Gold Coin is on Hand. MINTS WILL START TO WORK OVERTIME San Francisco and Philadelphia Ordered to Supply Demand for Double Eagles as Fast as Possible.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 31.—For the first time in many years the treasury finds itself without any gold coin in its vaults. It is explained that this condition is the result of an unprecedented demand for gold certificates during the time when the mints have been fully employed in coining Philippine silver and subsidiary silver for the United States.

EYES ON BRITISH EMPIRE Session of Parliament Promises to Be One of Great Importance. FUTURE POLICY OF EMPIRE IS INVOLVED

Balfour Following and Chamberlain Party Will Face Bitter Opposition When Fiscal and Tariff Questions Are Raised. LONDON, Jan. 30.—King Edward will open in full state on February 21 what promises to be one of the most interesting and important sessions in the history of the British Parliament.

Since Parliament adjourned in June last, not only has the cabinet been entirely reconstructed, but the party lines have been completely broken. Seven distinct factions will take seats in the House of Commons Tuesday. They are the followers of Premier Balfour, who favor a policy of tariff retaliation, but who object to protection; the Chamberlain party, which insists that protection is necessary to the safety of the empire; the party of free traders, who are opposed to any tinkering with the fiscal system.
