Twenty-Two Names on Pay Roll

Nearly Two Thousand Arrests Were Made During the Year, Over Seven Hundred of Them for Drunkenness.

In his annual report for the year ending March 31, 1908, which he has just completed and filed with the Board of Police and Police Commissioners, Major George H. Richmond, chief of police, has this to say:

The growth of our city and the outlying districts, which are fast being built up, make an increase of the police force one of vital importance.

The report shows that the police force of Council Bluffs on March 31 consists of the chief, one assistant, two sergeants, four detectives, one deputy city marshal, and ten patrolmen, a total of twenty-two persons.

During the year fifty-four burglaries were reported and twenty-seven burglaries were frustrated.
