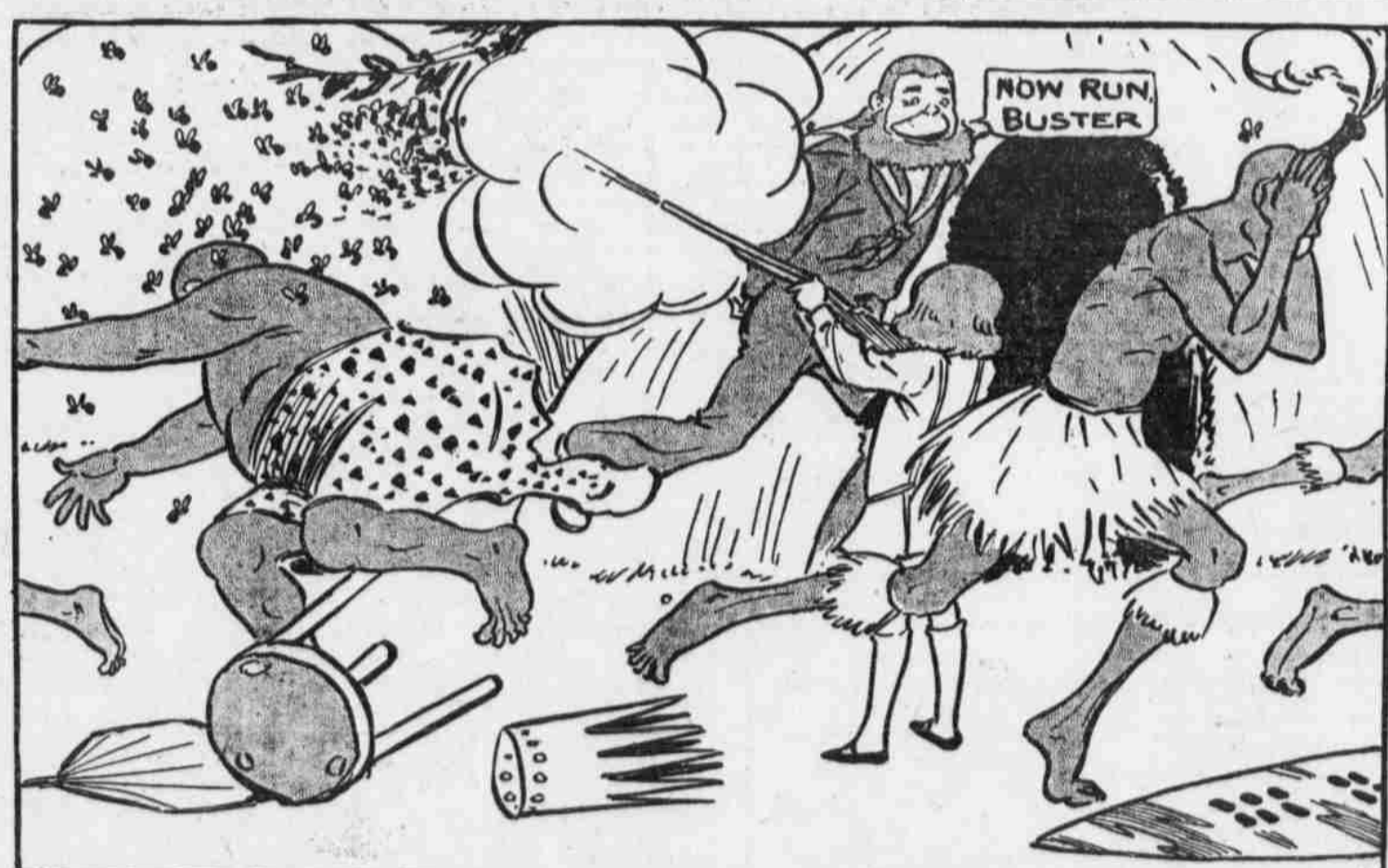
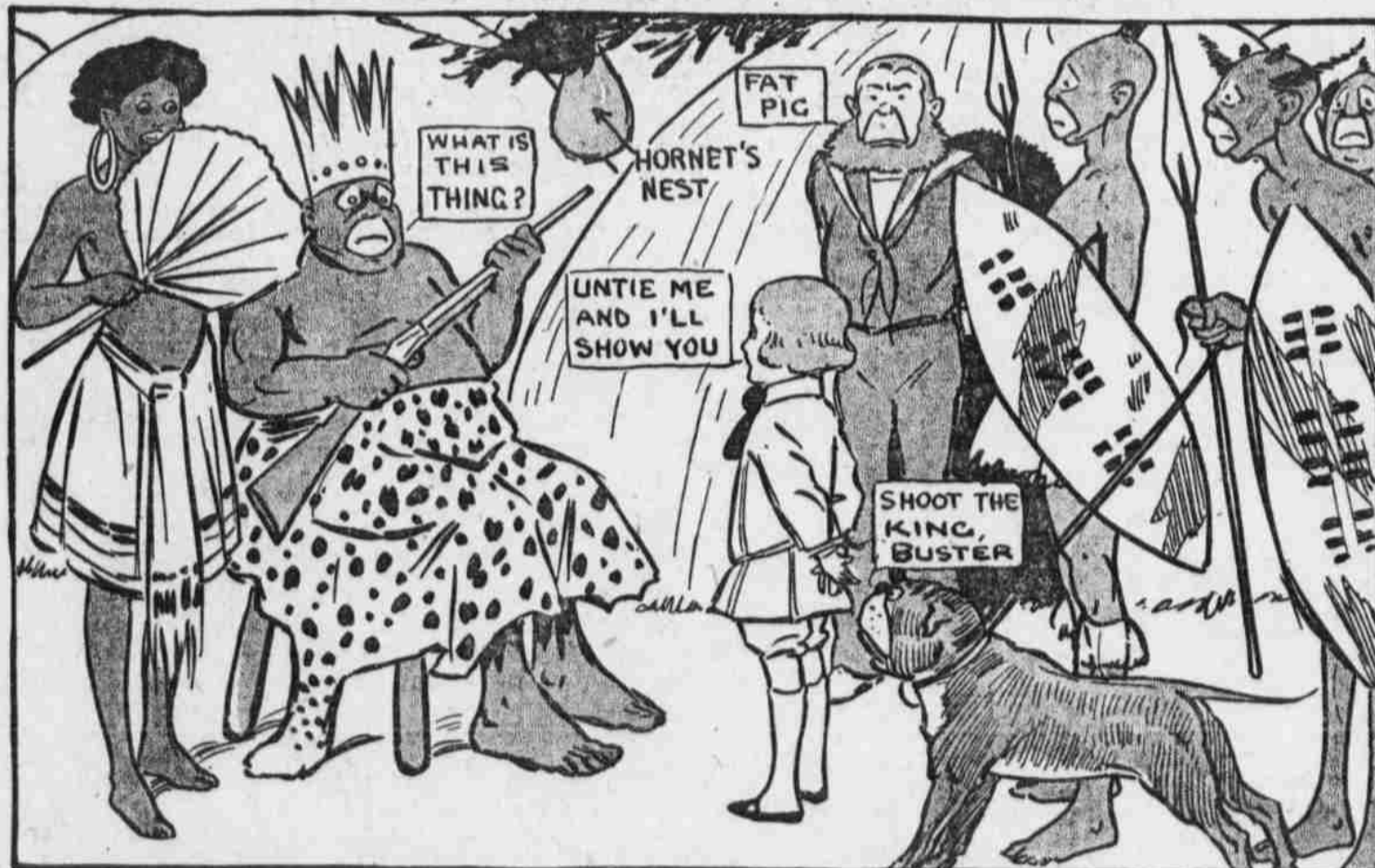
SO I JUMPS ON THE WHALE'S BACK —
