When the devil starts anything he always manages to far everything within his reach, and he's got a long arm.

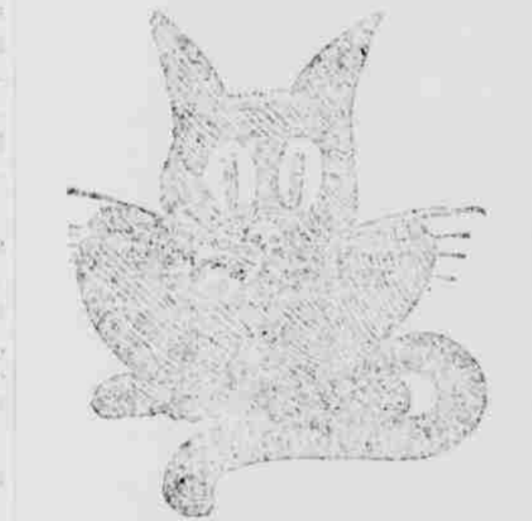
The problem of Hickory mothers has changed from getting the children off to school to having to put up with them all day. It's 50-50.
