Explosion Injures Eight Miners.
 FAIRMONT, W. Va., Aug. 7.—A terrific explosion of powder at Monongah mine No. 2 resulted in the injuring of eight miners, three of whom cannot recover, and probably two others will die. The accident happened in a peculiar manner. The men were in a mine car going down the slope of the mine entrance. One man on the rear of the car carried some cans of powder strung from a coal auger. This rested on his shoulder. A short circuit was formed when he accidentally touched the electric trolley wire over his head with the auger and the powder exploded. The injured were brought here by train and taken to the State hospital.

Von Sternburg at Oyster Bay.
 OYSTER BAY, N. Y., Aug. 7.—His Excellency Freiherr Speck von Sternburg, imperial German ambassador, attending Herr von Holleben, recently arrived, presented his credentials as ambassador to President Roosevelt received by him at Sagamore today. He was accompanied by von Dem Bussche-Haddenhausen, counselor of legation and first secretary. Keen interest was manifested in official circles here at this departure in precedent on the part of the present as a special mark of favor to the man envoy, who for more than ten years has been his intimate friend. This is the first time an ambassador ever presented to the president on the side of the White House.

Morgan's Greatest Bank Merger.
 NEW YORK, Aug. 7.—With an unprecedented capital of \$25,000,000, the merger of the National Bank of Commerce and Western National bank has been consummated by J. Pierpont Morgan. The combined deposits of the banks aggregate \$150,000,000. This brings to a realization the dream of Mr. Morgan of establishing the largest and most powerful bank on this continent. The merger will go into effect Oct. 5.
