What is Occurring And Being Talked
About In The Borough and Township

Salem has 1516 pupils enrolled, 42
more than last year.

Architects have been submitting plans
for a banking house for Peoples Bank.

Charles Norton is the night policeman

Cove.

The cold freezing weather and snow
has delayed building operations this
week.

Fertilizers have begun to arrive for the
farmers who will soon be rushed with
work because the season will be late and
help scarce.

The opening of the Carney Point Post
office has relieved Penns Grove office
somewhat, altho there are ten or a dozen
usually waiting. Last Saturday forty
were in line at the new post office.

Surveyors have been working along
the Salem branch of the West Jersey &
Seashore Railroad between Woodbury and
Swedesboro, and the report is current that
the road is to be electrified.

Three long train loads of powder left
Carney Point Tuesday night for the
Allies. It is published in daily papers
that American made powder has just
come into effective use in Europe.

Capt. Samuel M. Denny has sold all
the tract of land between Penn and
Franklin Streets he bought of Sieble
heirs. After being graded and surveyed
into lots it has been made a pleasing site
for homes.

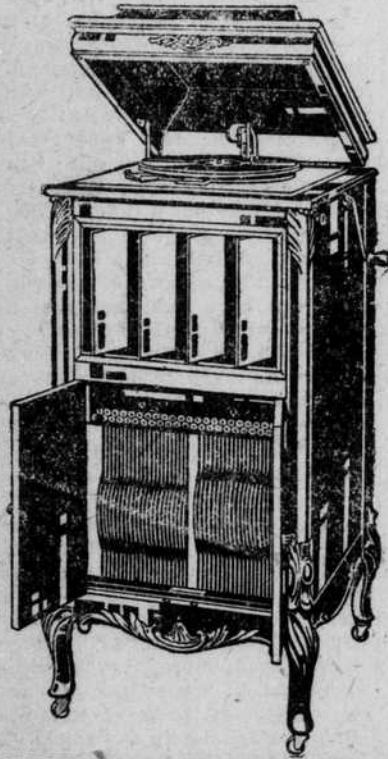
