

MONSTER NEW GAS RESERVOIR IS READY FOR USE

New Equipment Installed By Albuquerque Gas, Electric Light and Power Company Will Render Good Servie.

That the new gas reservoir opposite the Alvarado and east of the Santa Fe tracks will be ready for use in a few days, is the expectation of Manager F. B. Way, who has been accomplishing many improvements of late in the service of the Albuquerque Gas, Electric Light and Power Company.

Although the new structure will be employed for the regular storage of gas for city purposes, it will serve somewhat as an auxiliary chamber, in that a sufficient supply will be contained to tide over the times when there is the heaviest demand upon the service. These times are occasioned by the advent of the summer months, when a greater quantity of fuel gas is consumed, and during the repair of the generating plant. With the new equipment there will be but the slightest variation in pressure when improvements are being made.

Automatic registers are being used in all portions of the city to detect unreasonableness in the gas pressure in order that larger pipes may be supplied and the differences adjusted wherever they may occur.

The supply at present contained in the cylinder will be allowed to flow through piping to the new receptacle. This process will cause two breaks of short duration in the city gas supply, which will be amply advertised to the patrons in advance.

An ingenious plan to utilize the old substation, whose boilers were abandoned with the installation of the new turbine steam fire gas, has been given up after much careful consideration.

Other activities, however, are engaging the attention of the company.

WAR COSTS MONEY LIVES AND MUCH SUFFERING

Baron De Constant Peace Missionary Tells in Speech. What He Has Learned on Subject.

San Francisco, April 4.—Baron d'Estournelles de Constant, the French missionary in the cause of international peace, who is making a tour of the country, spoke here today, taking as his text "The Campaign in Russia." The baron said, in part:

"General ignorance has been singularly useful to governments in concealing the consequences of their wars from the eyes of public opinion.

"For a long time I have been endeavoring to find out what the war is doing to the world and the human race. I have found that the war is doing nothing but suffering, death and destruction.

"We must also take into account the immense opportunities lost by France in all parts of the world and especially in America. The courage and heroism displayed during a quarter of a century of war were not called into being by it, as some people imagine, but were already in existence and ready to be utilized in France and abroad.

"On another occasion, Napoleon remarked to M. de Narbonne (according to the Duc de Broglie, quoted by Taine): 'After all the Russian campaign only cost me 300,000 men, and a great many of them were Germans.'

REDUCTION PLANT TO BE BUILT NEAR BISBEE

The Santa Fe Company to Erect a Heavy Mill to Handle Ores From Its Properties in Sonora.

Bisbee, April 4.—Preparing to make a deal whereby the Santa Fe Mining company, whose property is located south of Cananea, can erect a mill for reduction of its ores, P. J. Tehaney is now in San Francisco.

Several months ago, P. J. Tehaney, A. D. Nanny and associates, secured a lease upon the property and commenced systematic development. This was accomplished by such good results that the owners for that riches turned their backs upon the reduction in Mexico came to unseemly plans.

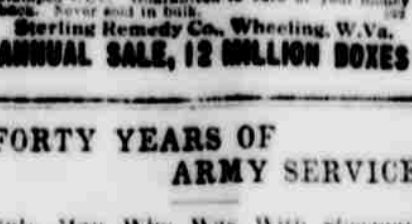
