SHERMAN ACT IS SUNKEN MINE. HE SAYS

Iowa City, Ia., June 14.—Declaring the Sherman act "even as now interpreted an ineffective remedy to the just complaint of the ordinary man against monopolies," Judge Peter S. Grosscup...

Judge Grosscup's discussion of the remedy proposed by him was prefaced by a review of the Sherman act in which he said:

"An interpreted remedy to May of this year the Sherman anti-trust act was introduced to be scrapped in the hands of the administration at Washington...

"Not will the Supreme court continue Judge Grosscup's attack on the Sherman act? It is a question which will be decided when the time comes to take the act out of the statute books...

"To that extent, at least, I am for the new nationalism. Only by the aid of a single sovereignty, and that the supreme sovereignty, can the principle of the Sherman act be effectively applied to the big business trusts...

"But where should be the line of separation, you ask, between those who are to be nationally incorporated and those left to the states and local governments? It is a question which is being asked in many of the manufacturing and trading corporations in any given field of enterprise...

"The national bureau of corporations has already begun to inform us that will show what those percentages are. Whenever they are decided can be easily supplied. I will not undertake to say here what should be the precise percentage that would bring the corporation within national control...
