holders of the territory are far in excess of a reasonable compensation for the services performed. I therefore, will do nothing to prevent this legislation as proposed by house bill No. 31, and will, so far as lies in my power, encourage the passage of the same.

Following is the receipt given Mr. Beaven by Mr. Pinney, when the part of the funds were turned over yesterday, and which may be of interest to some of the tax payers:

"Received of John S. Beaven, this 14th day of January, 1909, check No. 316 in the sum of sixty-six thousand three hundred thirty-two dollars and fifty-five cents, to apply on balance due Bernalillo county as shown by books of said county together with fifty dollars on deposit with N. W. Harris & Co. of New York city, and a payment of twenty thousand one hundred sixty dollars and thirty-two cents, made January 7, 1909, making a total paid to Edward Pinney of eighty-six thousand five hundred forty-two dollars and eighty-seven cents. INVESTIGATE THE ELECTION.

Denver, Jan. 15.—A joint resolution for the appointment of a commission to consist of two senators and three members of the House to investigate alleged election frauds in Las Animas and Huerfano counties was adopted by the Senate today and was then sent to the House.

A TOWBOAT WRECKED.

Pittsburg, Jan. 15.—As the result of a peculiar accident the towboat Dave Wood sunk at the government dam No. 4 in the Ohio river today. The twenty-three members of the crew reached the shore safely, several having narrow escapes. While passing over the dam it is supposed that the suction caused by the boat's movement drew up one of the wickets, which punched a hole through the hull.

MARINES BACK TO SHIPS.

Washington, Jan. 15.—By a unanimous vote the House committee on naval affairs today agreed to recommend the placing of marines on ships of the navy, contrary to the action of the president. This action was taken following the taking of testimony which has lasted several days. Admiral Evans was the last witness. He approved the recent order of the president, removing the marines from ships and urged their organization into battalions, but still as part of the navy.
