SMELTER WILL GO TO CANON CITY INDIANS ENJOY ANNUAL CORN DANCE

Tri-Bullion Company Decides to Locate Plant in Colorado. Feast Going On Among Red Men of Many Tribes.

Several days since, Canon City, Colo., announced that the smelter of the Tri-Bullion Mining company would be built in that city, but it was believed here until yesterday evening that Albuquerque might be selected as the point for the location of the plant. A telegram from P. F. McCanna, who has been in New York for several days looking after this city's interests with the officials of the Tri-Bullion company, was received late yesterday by G. L. Brooks, president of the Commercial club, stating that the smelter would be located either at Florence or Canon City, Colo. Today a telegram states that Canon City has been definitely selected as the location.

This smelter is an independent concern, not owned by the trust, and while it would be comparatively a small plant, would be of considerable benefit to any community, hence the Commercial club began an active campaign some time since to secure the industry for Albuquerque. Officials of the company visited the city frequently and every concession they asked was satisfactorily met and every objection overcome. For a time it seemed probable that the smelter would be located here, but the Tri-Bullion company recently purchased a million dollar zinc reduction plant near Canon City, the officials of the concern finally decided to erect the new smelter in close proximity to that plant in order to concentrate their interests.

The cost of the new plant will also be greatly reduced by building it in connection with the zinc reduction. The latter plant was built in Colorado to fight the trust and after a stormy existence, its owners were glad to sell it for a very low price to the Tri-Bullion company. This was the point which determined the location of the smelter. President Brooks, of the Commercial club, stated today that the club has two other propositions for industries, either of which he considers of equal value with the smelter, hence he is not discouraged by the loss of that industry.

Santa Fe, N. M., August 1.—The funeral of the late William Bolander was held this afternoon followed by interment at the National cemetery. At 2:30 o'clock short services were conducted at the residence of Rev. J. W. Purcell, pastor of the First Presbyterian church, after which the body was taken in charge of by an escort consisting of members of Carleton Post No. 3, Grand Army of the Republic, and Santa Fe Lodge No. 2, Independent Order of Odd Fellows. Both organizations observed the customary burial rites at the cemetery. As the casket was being lowered in the grave a salute was fired by a squad of Company F, First Infantry, New Mexico national guard, under command of First Sergeant J. H. McHughes.

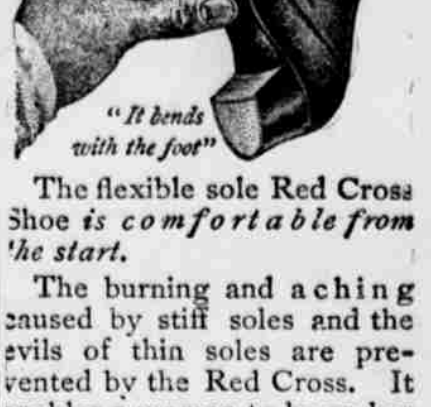

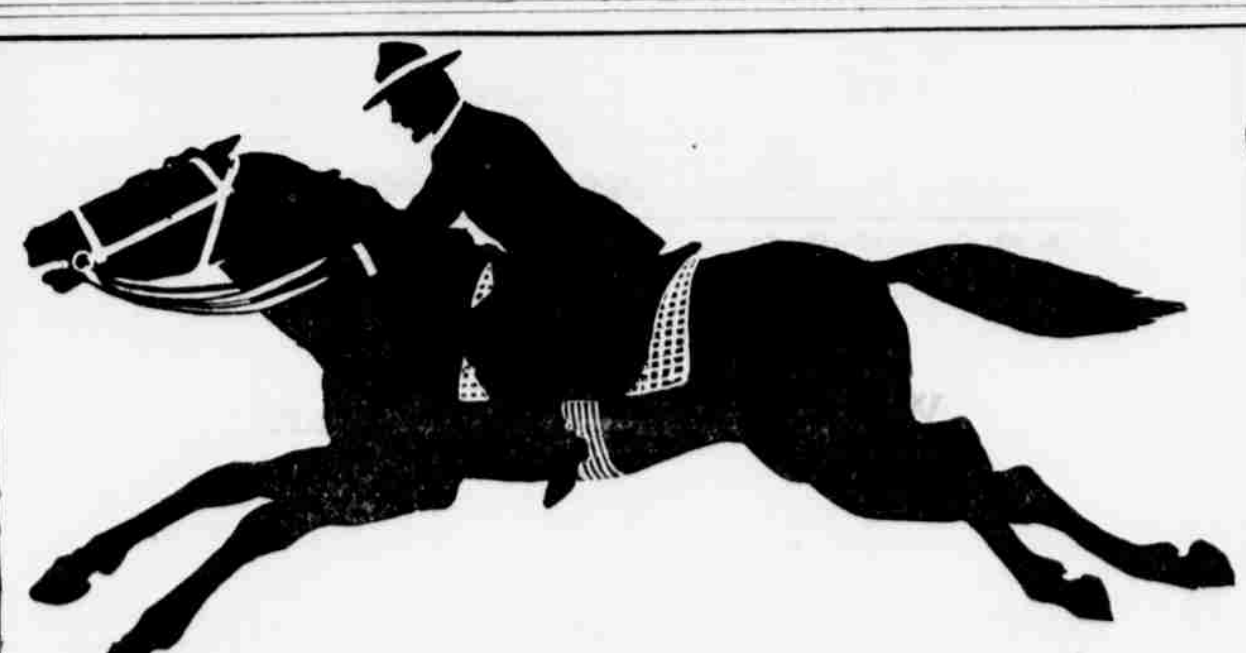
