There will be no other specimens of the work of the institute and its industrial department. Yvonne, Gladys, Marie and Louise are all blind, and show how the pupils are taught to read music.

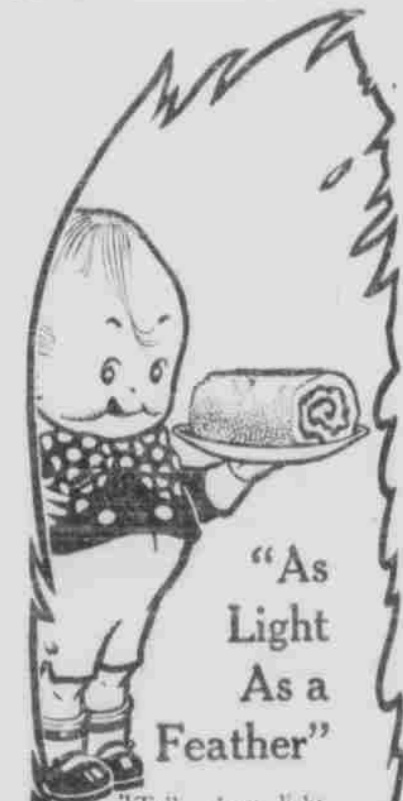
State Engineer to Inspect Roads.

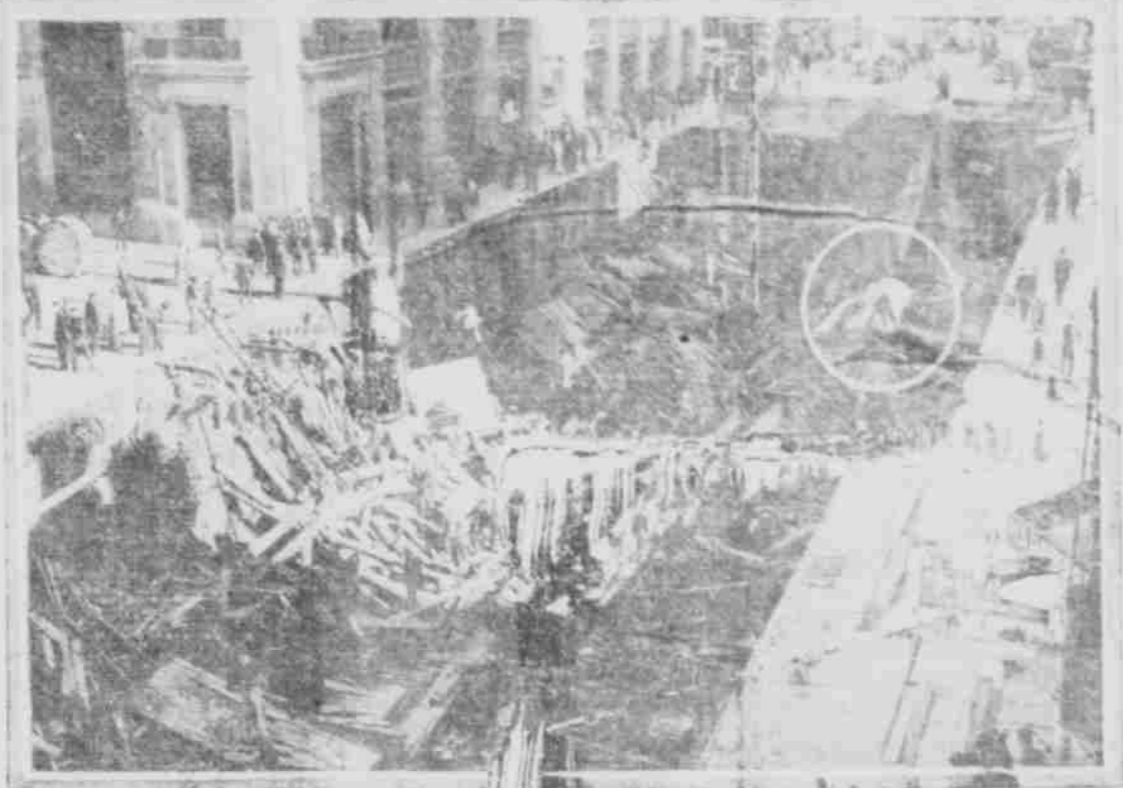
