

# EXPRESS WRECK ON N. Y. CENTRAL TIES UP TRAFFIC

Two Men Injured When Cars  
Crash Into Boulder and Are  
Hurled From Tracks.

POUGHKEEPSIE, N. Y., Nov. 22.—A wreck, which interrupted traffic on the Hudson Division of the New York Central for the greater part of to-day, occurred about one mile south of Rhinebeck at 4.30 A. M. to-day. The American Express train, known as No. 24, southbound, running half an hour late, was derailed by driving into a boulder which had slid down on the tracks. Ten cars were thrown over. The engineer and fireman were seriously, but not fatally, injured, and were brought to the hospital in this city. There were no passengers on the train. A few minutes after the wreck occurred the railroad company's doctors from here and from Hyde Park went to Rhinebeck on the wrecking train. The newspaper train from New York, bound for the West, was sent back to New York and then north over the Harlem Division, and this division is being used for through traffic, while the Hudson Division is being cleared. The wreck occurred opposite the Levi P. Morton estate in a rock cut where two extra tracks are being laid. The locomotive crashed into the boulder with such force that it was thrown from the track and across the entire roadbed and every one of the ten cars it was hauling left the rails. A carload of chickens was on a siding close to where the locomotive struck. About 200 of these were killed and 200 or 400 got loose. The laborers employed by the railroad in the operations at the scene of the wreck were busy all the morning chasing the chickens. At the hospital here it was said that Engineer Stroh and Fireman Paul Miller, while badly scalded and in serious condition, had every chance of recovery.

**Deported Chauffeur Dies.**  
George Millington, a chauffeur from Stafford, England, died in the steerage of the Mauretania at her pier in the North River to-day just before she sailed. He arrived in this country on the Caronia on Nov. 13 and was ordered to be deported on account of his health. His body was removed to the morgue. He is known to have friends in Meriden, Conn.
