30,000 MEN ILLEGALLY REGISTERED IN LOS ANGELES

Warrants for That Many Will Be Issued on Evidence That Has Been Collected.

LOS ANGELES, Nov. 22.—As the result of a conference held by Harry Lelande, County Clerk; C. E. Sbaastian, Chief of Police, and Byron Hanna, Deputy District-Attorney, it was announced today that complaints will be issued charging illegal registration on the part of approximately 30,000 men.

The information necessary to issuing the warrants is being collected by

County Clerk Lelande, and he believes that it is sufficient to convict all the men charged with fraud.
