

# DURLAND SUICIDE CAUSED BY WIFE'S SUIT FOR DIVORCE

Socialist Writer Preferred  
Death to Separation and  
Drank Cyanide on Train.

FELL DYING BESIDE HER.

Wife Had Watched Him Take  
Dose, Not Knowing It  
Was Poison.

Ever since his efforts to secure a reconciliation with his wife, the former Mrs. Robert T. Haines, who had begun suit for divorce, is the motive ascribed for the suicide of H. Kellogg Durland, Socialist, settlement worker, investigator and author, who took cyanide of potassium in presence on a train in the Union station at 1 A. M. Sunday. He collapsed at her feet and was dead in the ambulance reached the Relief Hospital.

Mrs. Durland, whose maiden name was Miss Genevieve Greville, was the author of "Heart's Flame," in which Robert T. Haines is said to be the author several years ago. No information of her whereabouts could be obtained today at her home, No. 107 West 17th place, or at the Hermitage, Forty-second street and Seventh avenue, where Durland had lived.

Durland had spent some days seeking his wife, who went to Boston last week. He succeeded in locating her only after she had boarded the 1 A. M. train. After a short conversation with her, he obtained a drink of water and poured a powder into it. Mrs. Durland watched him drink it, entirely unaware that her husband was swallowing poison.

Except a few officials no one knew of the death of the writer until today. At the hospital the name was entered as "Kellogg Kurkind." It was thought Durland had died of heart disease and the strictest secrecy was maintained.

until experts at the Harvard Medical School had made an examination. Kellogg Durland was thirty years of age. He was educated at Harvard, the University of Edinburgh and the High School of Social Studies at Paris, and then devoted himself to the investigation of industrial abuses.

He was a close friend of J. G. Phelps Stokes, who was best man at the latter's wedding to Rose Pastor. He was also an intimate friend of the Union Sincera and of Artist Ferdinand May Earle. For two years he was a worker at the University Settlement in New York.

The nature of the trouble between the couple was unknown to their friends. But on Nov. 7 Mrs. Durland had her husband served with divorce papers. He was doing some work for a Boston paper at the time.

It is understood that Mrs. Durland

then informed him that she was about to sail for London and that her visit to Boston last week was for the purpose of winding up their joint affairs and saying goodbye.

Durland was known by many friends here to be dependent over the separation. He is said to have written some of his intimates telling them of his grief and his wish to die.

The last five weeks of his life were filled with trouble. He was arrested on a charge of giving a fraudulent check in payment of a board bill at the Hotel Hermitage in New York. His wife stood by him then and declared that the arrest was revenge for an article Durland had written for a Boston paper backing up Magistrate Corrigan against Mayor Gaynor as to the New York "crime wave." The trial was due shortly.

A week ago Durland sent letters to friends in which he declared that he would take his own life if he was not able to win back his wife, who he had learned was living in seclusion with friends in Ware. The son of his friends in Ware. The son of his friends
