

SAYS THE GILSEY IS A GOLD BRICK

Albert R. Keen Declares He Was Deceived Regarding the Business the Hotel Was Supposed to Be Doing.

INSTEAD OF PROFIT COMPANY WAS LOSING.

Lessees Want Lease Set Aside and Rent Reduced, So They Will Be Able to Make the Venture Pay.

The talk of Broadway to-day is the suit of the Seaboard Hotel Company, lessees of the Gilsey House, against the executors and heirs of the estate of Andrew Gilsey to have the company's seven year lease, taken March 1 last, set aside. Frederick J. Lancaster is President of the Seaboard Hotel Company, and Albert R. Keen is Treasurer. Both are experienced hotel men, but they allege that they were induced to make the Gilsey House under false pretenses.

Elwood O. Roessle ran the hotel up to the first of last March. He did a great deal of refurbishing when he took the house after the Berlin regime, and it is alleged in the suit brought by Lancaster & Keen, that he represented to them that he was making money. They say that they were told that the receipts were \$300,000 a year, and the expenses a little over \$240,000 a year, and that everything was in tip-top shape.

Now they discover, they say in their papers, that Roessle was losing money all along. Mr. Keen was asked to-day how he, an experienced and sharp hotel man, could have been taken in on a losing proposition. He said he was a victim of confidence in the Gilseys. "It is up to me," he said, "Peter Gilsey came to me and told me that Roessle was anxious to get out in order to help his father, who runs the Arlington in Washington. Mr. Gilsey represented to me that he wanted me to take the house and that he would let me in on the ground floor. He represented to me that it would be a good idea to save Roessle's fee, and so on, and insisted that I should keep everything under cover. I talked with Roessle and he assured me that he was making money."

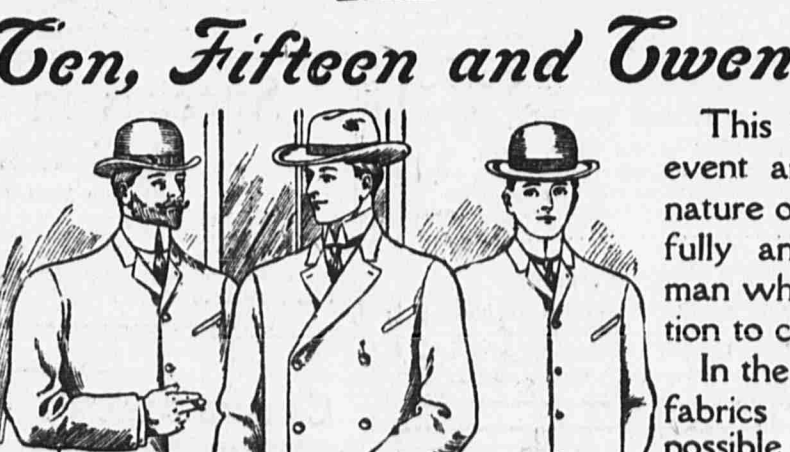
