MAY ARREST AGONCILLO.

HE PLACES HIMSELF IN THE POSITION OF AN ENEMY.

Sends a Despatch to the Junta at Hong Kong Giving the Status of the Treaty and Saying That Now is the Time to Strike for Independence Before Our Reinforcements Can Reach Gen. Otis.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 25.—Evidence of a damaging character against Felipe Agoncillo, the agent sent to Washington by Aguinaldo, has been discovered by the Government, and the nature of Agoncillo's offense is regarded as so serious that no doubt is felt in official circles that the punitive measures to put a stop to the system of espionage established by the Filipino emissary will be justified.

Native Congress Gives Aguinaldo Power to Declare War at Any Time. Special Cable Despatch to The Sun.

HONO KONO, Jan. 23.—The Filipino Congress at Malolos has passed a resolution expressing confidence in Aguinaldo, and empowering him to declare war at any time and for any purpose that he may deem expedient.

The strictest form of martial law prevails at Manila. No natives are permitted to be in the streets after 10 o'clock at night.

Whether the despatch was written in a secret cipher or in Spanish or some other language was not ascertained, but at any rate the despatch succeeded in obtaining a copy of the message in its plain English version.

That action the Government will take in dealing with Agoncillo remains to be seen. It is evident, from the fact that the message was received so promptly, that Agoncillo is being closely watched.

London Papers Fear that the Filipino's Attitude Means War. Special Cable Despatch to The Sun.

LONDON, Jan. 27.—The papers here are impressed by the increasing gravity of the position in the Philippines. They fear that the defiant, passionate attitude of the Filipinos renders war probable, if not imminent.

COMPLAINTS AT HAVANA.

GEN. BROOKE AND GEN. WOOD COVER UP THE SITUATION.

Demands that the Cuban Army Be Paid Continue—One Cuban General Says Our Government is Worse Than Weyler's—Feb. 24 Chosen as a National Holiday.

HAVANA, Jan. 26.—Avelino Borna, a General in the Cuban Army, who is a native of the Republic of Colombia, and who came to Cuba with Gen. Calisto Garcia on the Bermuda expedition in 1895, publishes a signed article in the Cuban press in which he says that the American Government is worse than Weyler's, and the blockade established by the United States exterminated the pacifists and was inhumane.

The agitation concerning the payment of the army is growing. The Cuban General Assembly will meet at Marianao on Feb. 15 to consider the subject. Señor Lanuza and the other Cuban officers who wish to satisfy the United States will be heard regarding their efforts in Washington.

The Cuban Assembly issued a manifesto advising the Cubans to keep quiet until it is officially known what the United States Government has decided to do regarding the Cuban army.
