

PAY UP ALIMONY OR STAY IN JAIL, HOTALING'S FATE

Justice Fitzgerald Rejects Plea
of Real Estate Expert for
a Reduction.

NOW \$1,500 IN ARREARS.

Moved From City, but Was
Caught When He Came
to Earn Fat Fee.

John Wilson Hotaling, who has been in Ludlow Street Jail since Thanksgiving, will have to stay there until he can make a better showing than he did to-day before Justice Fitzgerald of the Supreme Court, on an application for relief from that part of the decree of absolute divorce granted to his wife, Clara Hotaling, which directs that he pay her \$30 weekly alimony and \$10 a week each for the support of the children—John Wilson Hotaling, Jr., 14 years old, and Abeline Laura Hotaling, 10 years old, until each has reached twenty-one.

Hotaling has never paid any alimony, although it was shown on the trial of the case before a referee that he had been maintaining an affinity, Lucille Bernard, in luxurious style in an apartment at West End avenue and Ninety-sixth street for several years.

Delayed the Proceedings.

He managed to stave off the alimony case for a year, and even stayed the filing of a final decree from May to November, 1907, when Justice Newburger signed the decree. He fought it through the Appellate Division. Losing there, he came back to Justice Dowling for a reduction of alimony, and while the matter was before the Court moved with Miss Bernard to Atlantic Highlands, in Jersey, and beyond the reach of the New York divorce court.

From there he entered into negotiations with his former wife for an agreement to receive less alimony, but this failed.

Hotaling is one of the most reliable real estate experts in Greater New York, and much in demand as an expert witness in big condemnation proceedings before the Commissioners in the Geiken Building, and he has been missing many large fees which he might have earned. He ventured over the river to appear in one of these proceedings on Nov. 21 last, and a deputy sheriff with an order for his arrest as a delinquent member of the Alimony Club swooped down upon him.

Makes a Last Appeal.

Langueishing in Ludlow Street Jail while your affinity is crying her eyes out somewhere also is tiresome. Hotaling made a last appeal to Justice Fitzgerald for relief. It was in arrears \$1,500 in alimony when he was locked up in Castle Ludlow, and he solemnly declared it would be impossible for him to pay it. Besides, he declared, "John Wilson Hotaling, Jr., is not Clara's child, but the child of my first wife."

But Mrs. Hotaling rejoined to this that the little boy was the child of her dead husband, and only a baby when his mother died. She became the second Mrs. Hotaling, and says she has cared for the child as her own ever since. Hotaling's name is on the door bell at Lucille Bernard's home, and she is known to the neighbors as Mrs. Hotaling.

Hotaling has an office at No. 28 Broadway, and is a high-priced man in his line of business.

Justice Fitzgerald denied his appeal for release without a word of comment. That \$1500 arrears will have to be made up, and a bond given for future performance given.


