Resolved, That the basis of representation in said Convention shall be one vote for every 100 votes, or fraction of 50 or over 50, cast at the last general election for the Republican State tickets, to-wit:

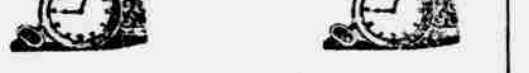
