Defendants Discharged.

The case of the State of Nevada against the Whites was on trial before Justice Peters on Tuesday and Wednesday of this week. The evidence against the Whites was largely circumstantial. Lewis Borchering, the witness who was relied upon to furnish material evidence in the case, after being seen in company with the Whites, had a serious lapse of memory and denied making statements that other witnesses testified he had made to them concerning his knowledge of the Whites absconding with the "Mormon Boy's" horses. Perjury was committed by somebody, and there is a pretty unanimous opinion as to who committed it. The Whites made no statement as to how they got out of the country, and on motion of the prosecuting attorney Justice Peters discharged the defendants for lack of evidence.

Meanwhile the divers and sundry debts of the White brothers remain unpaid. Mr. Van Newman secured judgment against them on a note for \$109 and costs, but no property was found. Their other creditors, who were bilked into helping them when they first started into business, have concluded to pocket their losses.

The best thing that can be said about the Whites is that they are leaving the State—it is to be hoped for good.

Improving the Butler Ranch.

Frank Kopp pulled out this week from Eureka with ten animals and two wagons loaded with lumber, provisions and furniture for Jim Butler's ranch in Monitor valley, Nye county. We understand it is Mr. Butler's intention to make extensive improvements on his Nye county ranch, and another large consignment of material for constructing the new buildings is expected to arrive here shortly.—Eureka Sentinel.
