Consumption of Copper.

A Boston publication, of recent date, gives some figures relative to the consumption of copper in the requirements of electricity. It is claimed that the telephone interests of the country consume about 60,000,000 pounds of copper per annum and the General Electric and Westinghouse interests about the same amount. Miscellaneous railroad enterprises, associated with electricity, it is claimed, would probably bring the total electrical consumption of copper in the country up to 200,000,000 pounds, or one-third of the output. The larger part of the telephone requirements this year were contracted for some time ago at an average of less than 12 cents per pound. It is also asserted that the telephone interests consume as much copper as the Westinghouse and General Electric combined.

Another Company Forming.

The San Francisco Mining and Engineering Review is authority for the statement that Messrs. C. H. Jordan and George Penner, of San Francisco, closed a deal with Philadelphia capitalists, whereby eastern men secure control of eleven claims adjoining the Colehan group at Gold Mountain. This property has enhanced greatly in value since such rich ore has been found at Gold Mountain. A company is being formed, mostly of Philadelphia men, who will start operations in the near future.

All for Tonopah.

The Virginia and Truckee railroad company will at once put on another train to handle Tonopah freight, which has accumulated to an alarming extent in Reno. The people of the mining camp are clamoring for their goods but so far the railroad companies have been unable to catch up, and have arranged for increased facilities so as to relieve the stagnation.—Reno Journal.

It is reported that the Southern Pacific company has issued an order that no more narrow gauge ties are to be put in the C. & C. roadbed. Broad gauge ties will be used in repairs. It is also said that the company will build a broad gauge road from Mojave to Keeler. It looks very much as if the company intends to make the road a broad gauge from Mound House to Mojave.
