

ORDINANCE NO. 105

An Ordinance granting to the Carson Light and Power Company the right to erect and maintain electric wires and poles in the City of Carson...

The Board of Trustees of Carson City do ordain:

Section 1. The right is hereby granted to the Carson Light and Power Company, its successors and assigns, to construct, maintain and operate in the City of Carson, and in and upon the streets, alleys and thoroughfares thereof...

Section 2. The poles, masts and other apparatus for supporting the wires, or other means of conducting electricity above the surface of the streets, ground and thoroughfares of said City shall be of sufficient height to cause no interference with public comfort...

Section 3. Said poles and wires shall be placed and maintained so as not to interfere with travel on said streets, alleys and thoroughfares or public ways...

Section 4. The Board of Trustees said Carson City expressly reserves the right and power, whenever in its judgment the public safety, welfare or convenience may so demand...

Section 5. The right of use herein given shall not be exclusive, and the Board of Trustees of said Carson City expressly reserves the power to grant like or other rights of way to others for electric purposes...

Section 6. In consideration whereof the said Carson Light and Power Company, its successors and assigns, shall, and by the acceptance of this Ordinance does, agree to allow the Board of Trustees of said Carson City to attach to or suspend upon or from the poles placed by said Carson Light and Power Company...

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, and the filing by said Carson Light and Power Company of an unconditional acceptance thereof in the office of the City Clerk of said Carson City, Nevada.
