On the 20th ult., the Committee on Territories reported a bill to the House for the organization of a Territorial government in Upper California.

Resolved, That the people of Jefferson prohibit the extension of slavery, after 1800, in all the territories of the United States, southern and northern; the votes of six States and sixteen delegates, in the Congress of 1781, for the proviso, to three States and seven delegates against it; the actual exclusion of slavery from the north-western territory, by the ordinance of 1787, unanimously adopted by the States in Congress; and the entire history of that period, clearly show that it was the settled policy of the nation, not to extend, nationalize, or encourage, but to limit, localize, and discourage slavery, and to this policy, which should never have been departed from, the government ought to return.

Resolved, That the Constitution of the United States was ordained "in order, among other great national objects, to establish justice, promote the general welfare, and secure the blessings of liberty; but expressly denies any power to the Federal Government to deprive any person of life, liberty, or property, without due legal process."
