

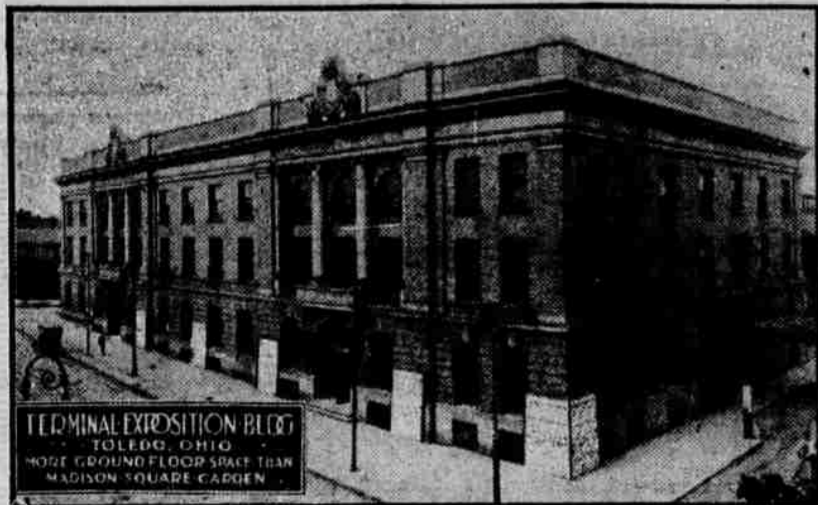
## FARMERS NATIONAL EXPOSITION HONORS AMERICAN FARMER

### STATE APPLE SHOW WILL BE BIGGER THAN EVER

Farmers from all over the United States who will gather in Toledo commencing December 6 to 14 inclusive, to attend the National Farmers' Exposition, will be interested in the 8th Ohio State apple show, which will be a feature of the exposition. Indications are that the apple show

Special decorations from Chicago have arrived and are being put into place. Flags and gay autumn foliage against a white background give a festive appearance to the big auditorium, and form an appropriate setting for the many fine displays.

The main floor has been given over chiefly to the industrial exhibits, which include 25 tractors of every variety, 8 grain separators and 16 motor trucks all of which will be demonstrated daily. The state apple show will also be an important feature.

The balcony exhibitions will include township and county war garden products and institutional displays. The Red Cross, War Mothers and similar war organizations will have booths.

R. T. Skinner, of the Toledo Commerce Club, will establish headquarters at the exposition during the week, and be ready at all times to furnish out of town people with information about Toledo.

Special musical programs will be given every afternoon and evening. The large theater where moving pictures will be shown, will be open to visitors each afternoon and evening.

### AN EXPOSITION OF GREAT INTEREST TO EVERYONE

Special features have been scheduled for practically every day of the National Farmers' Exposition, to be held in Toledo the week of Dec. 6.

The programs include information of vital interest to every farmer. More than 60 delegates, representing the various state brotherhoods of the Threshermen's Association, will be present Dec. 11 and 12, to attend the meetings of this organization. The sessions will be presided over by E. E. Parkinson, editor of The American Thresherman, published at Madison, Wis.

"Good Roads" day will be observed under the direction of the Lucas county Improvement Association. All township trustees, county commissioners and surveyors are expected to be present at this meeting. A. B. Sandies, secretary of the Ohio Macadam Association, will preside.

One day will be devoted to the interests of the Ohio sugar beet growers. It is also probable that the December meeting of the Ohio state board of agriculture will be held during the exposition.

The Exposition has the following endorsements—State of Ohio, Toledo Commerce Club, Thresherman, Retail Merchants Board, all Agricultural Organizations, Ohio State Horticultural Society, and Good Roads Advocates.

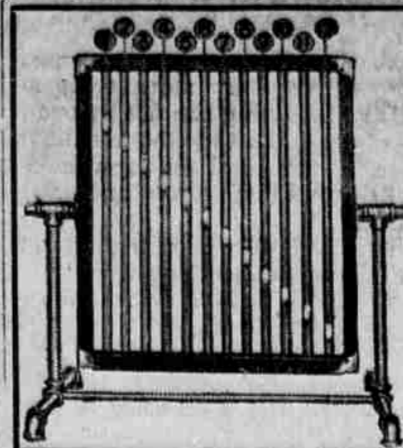
### PRESIDENT SIGNS BONE DRY LAW.

### GAME AND POULTRY ARE FEATURED AT FARM SHOW

Entries for the game and poultry show which will be one of the features of the National Farmers' Exposition to be held in Toledo Dec. 6 to 14, will number more than 125 pens.

The show, while not as large as previous exhibits, promises to be one of the finest ever held in Toledo. As the Poultry Growers Association will hold no independent exhibit this year, this will be the only opportunity offered Lucas county poultry growers to compete in a local show.

In addition to the poultry, pigeons and rabbits will be entered. Entries will be received up to Dec. 1.

The exposition, devoted to the interests of the American farmer, will include every possible phase of up-to-date farm production. An exhibition of tractors, grain separators and motor trucks, which will occupy a large portion of the main floor, giving daily demonstrations, will be a feature. Township and county exhibits and war garden produce will be shown.
