RIGHT WORTHY TEMPLARS.

Thirty-Third Annual Session at Saratoga—Proposition to Invite the American and English Branches.

Dynamite and Arms Used by Strikers in Belgium. Roy Muelder to North Carolina.

By the Associated Press. SARATOGA, N. Y., May 24.—The thirty-third annual session of Right Worthy Grand Lodge Templars convened in the Methodist Episcopal church at 10 o'clock this morning. The session will continue ten days, being the most important ever held by the body, as the question of a reunion of its two branches, which were separated ten years ago by a secession of some of the trans-Atlantic grand lodges, will come up for action through the united recommendations from both branches and advice from the most prominent members of the order in the west.

By the Associated Press. BRUSSELS, May 24.—Many of the men on the strike in the mining districts of Belgium possess arms and explosives. Many an outrage has been committed by the use of dynamite, including the destruction of machinery and the blowing up of the abodes of the managers of the mines. Several arrests have been made in connection with the outrages. At Croifstaet, an attempt was made to destroy the railway bridge with explosives. A riot has occurred at Verze-Sous-Chèvremont, arising from the strikers compelling German soldiers to stop work in the mines. A number of arrests were also made there. In consequence of night Socialist demonstrations in Brussels, provisions and gatherings in the public streets have been prohibited.

DROPPED DEAD. W. A. Partlebaugh, Esq., a Prominent Lawyer of Urbana, Expires Suddenly From Heart Disease.

Urbana, O., May 24.—W. A. Partlebaugh, esq., a wealthy and leading lawyer of this city, dropped dead this morning, supposedly of heart disease. He was a member of the firm of Partlebaugh & Bondard. Mr. Partlebaugh had been in usual health, and his sudden death is a profound shock to the community.

FOUND GUILTY. A Boy who Killed Three Others, and Wounded Two.

Wilmington, N. C., May 24.—Grant Best, a negro boy who killed three of his companions and wounded two others at one shot, a short time since, was found guilty of murder in the first degree in the criminal court today. At the time of the shooting there was a great crowd of spectators, and the result of earnestness. Best is only seventeen years of age.

A Kentucky Assassination. CINCINNATI, May 24.—A special from Georgetown, O., says: Marshal E. Whitaker was shot on the street yesterday while walking with his wife near his home. Henry B. Campbell, and dangerously wounded in the right arm and side. Campbell used a Springfield rifle. He had been arrested several times by the marshal, and only the day before the marshal interfered to stop Campbell's disorderly conduct at his own house. Campbell gave himself up.

Lightning Kills a Man on His Way From Prison to Meeting. DEXTER, Mo., May 24.—While a number of citizens were returning from prayer meeting, near Leora, Sunday night, James L. Butler was struck by lightning and instantly killed, and Ralph McCain was paralyzed and in a critical condition. Four companions were severely shocked.

Assassination and Suicide. ST. LOUIS, Mo., May 24.—A special from Houston, Texas, says: Wm. Warnicke, who shot his sister, Mrs. Rump, Saturday afternoon, went scarcely three hundred yards from the scene of his crime and blew out his own brains. His body has been found. Mrs. Rump is still alive.

Wind Storm in Kansas. LOVA, Kansas, May 24.—Last evening about 6 o'clock a storm of five dwellings and the school house, blowing six cars from the railroad track and doing considerable damage generally. Only one person was injured—a man named Reimsp. Several bridges were washed away.

Lightning and Beer Bill. WHITE HILL, Ill., May 24.—The son of Michael Welch was found dead beside the fence on Calvin Hick's farm. He was crossing a wheat field from a base ball game when he was struck by lightning.

Dynamite. LONDON, May 24.—A dynamite bomb exploded under the police court at Hebburn, Durham county, last night, partially destroying the building. The outrage is attributed to strikers.
