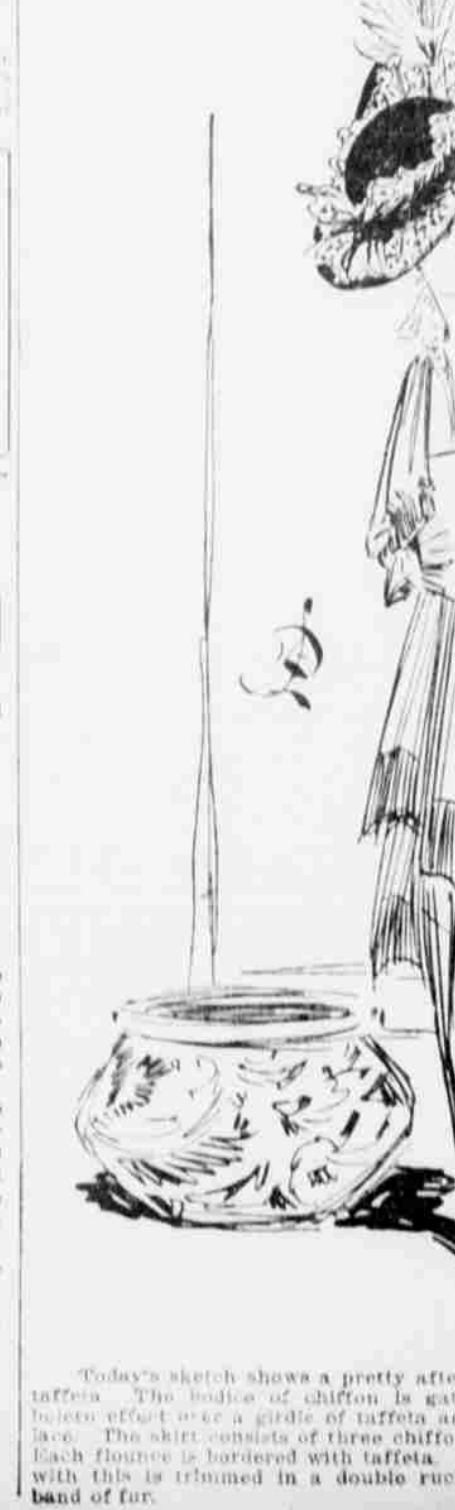

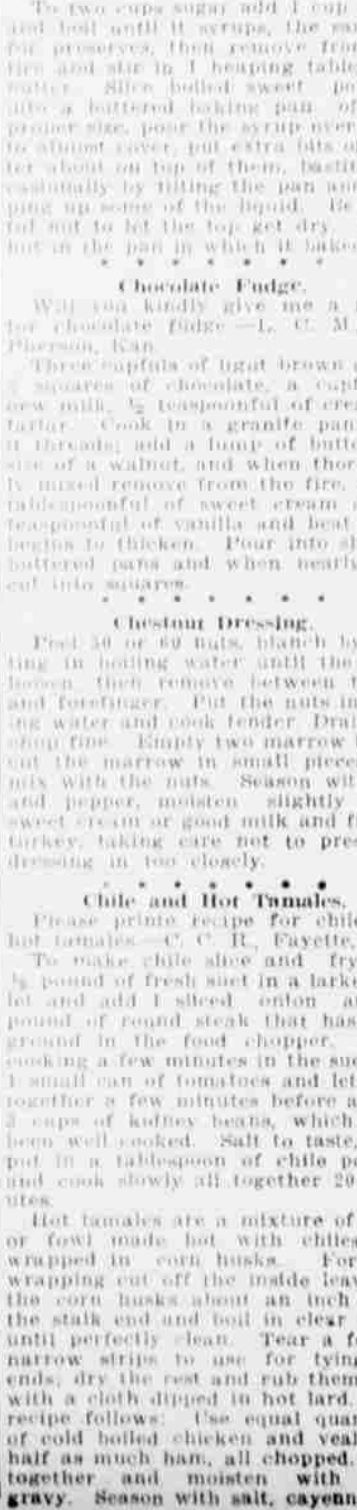

Coffee Cake.
 Take 1 cup butter, 1 cup sugar, 4 cups flour, 1 cup dark cold coffee, 4 eggs, 1 teaspoon of a teaspoon of ground nutmeg, 1 teaspoon cloves, 1 teaspoon soda sifted through the flour, 1 cup molasses, 1 pound raisins seeded, 1 cup currants and 1/2 pound dried citron cut into fine pieces. Bake slowly—Mrs. D. C. Mitchell.

Cleans Tarnished Silver.
 There is no need for the housewife to buy special compounds or polishes to clean tarnished silver, says the home economic department of the Nebraska Agricultural college. With a piece of zinc she can do the work just as well and much more cheaply. The blackening of silver is due to the formation of a compound with sulphur. This compound may be broken up by an electrolytic current produced in the following manner: In a vessel large enough to hold the silver to be cleaned place a strip or piece of zinc about the size of a person's hand. Add sufficient hot water to cover the silver. To each quart of water add about a teaspoonful of salt. An equal amount of soda is sometimes added, but is not necessary. Cold or warm water may be used, but the action of cold water is slower. Immerse

Goose Stuffing.
 Four cups hot mashed potatoes, 2 teaspoons onion juice, 1/2 teaspoon pepper, 1 teaspoon salt, 2 tablespoons butter, yolks of 2 eggs, 1-4 cup cream, 1 tablespoon parsley. Mix onion juice, pepper, parsley and butter with potato; add the cream to the potato, add chopped parsley.

Carrot Pudding.
 To 1 cup boiled finely mashed carrots add 2 well-beaten eggs, 1-4 cup sugar, 1/2 teaspoon each of cinnamon and grated nutmeg, 1-4 teaspoon salt and 1/2 cup each of milk and cream. Mix well, pour into a pudding dish and bake about half an hour in a hot oven. Insert a silver knife into the pudding, if nothing adheres to the knife the pudding is done. Serve cold with sweetened and flavored whipped cream.
