## HIGH SCHOOLS BOYS TO DEBATE AGAIN

The High School Debating Team, which was successful in its contest with the Duncan High School recently will be compelled to defend the honors won at that time, Saturday night March 13. The team is composed of Ray Pruett, Thomas Holland and James Armstrong.

This time the boys will debate against a High School located in another district. For the purpose of debate the High School League has divided the state into eight districts. In defeating Duncan High School, Anadarko became the ranking High School in this district. In each district these preliminary debates were conducted at about the same time. The following High Schools have been reported winners in their respective districts, Hooker, Blackwell, McCloud, Arapahoe, Anadarko and Tulsa, while the winners in the other two districts have not yet been determined. Now these schools are paired, and a second series of contests are being conducted.

Anadarko has been paired with McCloud, this part of the work having been arranged by the officers of the League. McCloud is a city having a High School not quite so large as Anadarko, but the debaters from that school seem to have been well chosen, having won from Shawnee. The Anadarko boys are not depending upon the size of the school to aid them, but realize that it must be their effort that will bring them off winners.

The question for debate is the same as that debated at the previous contest, Resolved that the legislature of Oklahoma should be reduced to a single branch of not more than twenty-five members, to be paid a fixed salary, and to remain in continuous session, or at such times as will enable them to perform fully the duties of the legislature. The Anadarko boys will defend the negative side of the proposition.

Aside from the desire to see the representatives of Anadarko High School win, the question has aroused considerable interest on the part of the High School pupils many of whom have been inclined to give some serious thought to the subject and to form individual opinions. It is a matter of very great current interest to all citizens also.

Notwithstanding the fact that the receipts from the last contest were not sufficient to pay the expenses of bringing the visiting team and the judges here, it has been decided to hold this second debate in Anadarko, and by arousing more interest, make an effort to cover that deficit by the receipts this time. The expenses on this occasion will be somewhat greater than before. It is hoped therefore, that the school patrons and citizens will show some interest in the matter and attend.

The Boys' and Girls' Glee Club will add entertainment by appearing in special numbers.
