

REFINERS KICK ON RATE HIKE

While the Western Refiners association has made, and will continue to make vigorous protest against the increase in railroad rates, both to the interstate commerce commission and to various railroads over which crude oil and refined products are hauled from this territory, it will at the same time begin a policy of developing its local trade territories more intensively in order to avoid long hauls, Fred W.
