TORNADO IN TEXAS

TOWN OF COLLINSVILLE STRUCK BUT NO LIVES LOST.

Terrific Storm Raged in Air Overhead and was Too High to Use its Strength—The Destruction Done Was by Suction.

Sherman, Tex., Oct. 19.—A severe windstorm struck the section of country about Collinsville about 7:30 o'clock Wednesday evening, particulars of which reached the city this morning. About this hour the people of Collinsville were alarmed by the swift approach of a heavy shower and fall of hail, which almost instantly roared across them with the sound of a heavy rain. The noise seemed to be almost deafening. Everybody who had a storm cellar made for it.

In less than three minutes the fury of the elements ceased, except for the receding roar, dying away toward the northeast. The results were seen this morning when it was learned that the greatest damage was in the south part of the town.

Ludd Elliott's large barn and granary is totally wrecked and the contents and timbers scattered over several acres.

The residence of Iverson Shirley was picked up and carried about thirty yards and wrenched out of shape. Fortunately, the family avoided the storm cellar and are unhurt.

The residence of Mrs. Mary Adams was blown off the blocks and set awry. No one was hurt.

The fences and the seats and grand stand at the baseball park were leveled to the ground.

The roof was blown from Waldo's elevator.

Hundreds of fruit and shade trees are broken and ruined.

Many fences and outhouses are overturned.

At least a mile of posts and wires of the Southwestern Telegraph and Telephone company south of Collinsville, between that place and Tioga, were on the ground this morning.

Down through the wooded draw, which the storm seemed to follow, many forest trees are torn up by the roots or broken down.

The main force of the storm seemed to have been just south of town, but all who observed the elements enough to see for themselves say that, in their judgment, a full-fledged tornado passed over, but at such a height that only the suction reached the ground and caused the damage reported, which will foot up an aggregate of several thousand dollars.
