MAY YET RECEIVE TRIBAL RIGHTS

FULL-BLOOD COMANCHE WOMAN AFTER MUCH WANDERING MAY GET TRIBAL RIGHTS

Washington, D. C., Jan. 17.—This is the story of Sun-a-was, a full-blood Comanche Indian woman whose memory runs beyond the time when the red man left the land east of the "Great Father of Waters" to take up his home on the vast prairie stretches in what is now the state of Oklahoma, and whose story so touched a congressman that he has taken the matter up with the government with the view that Sun-a-was may again come into the birthright of which she was robbed.

Years ago, Sun-a-was, as she watched the big red sun sink into the west and as she crooned to her people in the purple shadows of her teepee, was called by the spirit of wanderlust, and so it was that she roamed to far off Mexico, taking her children with her and where she was swallowed up in the wilderness, little knowing that the great united States government was going to divide up the lands of her tribesmen and give to each man, woman and child a farm of 160 acres in the fertile valleys of the Kiowa-Comanche country, where in years ago the buffalo had roamed at large until laid low by the arrow of the Indian huntsman.

Sun-a-was was gone, but her tribespeople had not forgotten her and whenever they gathered, they asked, "Where is our Sun-a-was?" Then some old brave would point to the southern horizon and the old Indian woman would again become but a memory.

Years went by until one day there came to the Kiowa agency at Anadarko a younger woman, whose dark eyes and darker tresses proclaimed her a woman with the blood of the Aztecs flowing in her veins. With this younger Mexican woman came thirteen children and then the story was heard that she was the daughter of Sun-a-was who had died in Mexico and that the thirteen children were the grandchildren of the old Comanche woman.

The government believed the woman's tale and, so accordingly, the woman and the thirteen children were each granted allotments of 160 acres of land, or 2,240 acres in all. The Comanches commenced to suspect and they discovered that the woman, representing herself as the daughter of Sun-a-was, was in reality a Mexican woman. Once aroused an Indian's suspicion and he must know the truth and so envoys from the Comanche tribe were dispatched to Mexico to learn the truth concerning Sun-a-was. The search took them over the greater part of the republic of Mexico, but they were finally rewarded by finding Sun-a-was, not dead and not only willing but eager to return to her own people, where her few remaining years might be passed in peace. That was two years ago, and for two years Sun-a-was, nonetheless, has wandered hither and thither like a lost soul.

Last November there strolled into the office of Representative Scott Ferris at Lawton a party of full-blood Comanches and with them they brought Sun-a-was, who told her story to the congressman and she made affidavit that all her children were dead and that the Mexican woman was not her daughter and that she had never even seen her. The truth of the woman's story appealed to Ferris and he has just taken up the matter with Commissioner of Indian Affairs, Valentine, who has ordered that the matter be thoroughly investigated in order that the alleged fraud may be uncovered and Sun-a-was be given the land which is her due.

Mr. Ferris has received a letter from a full-blood Comanche Indian constituent of his at Walter, Okla., in which he says among other things: "When you get this letter you must show this letter to your friend, our Indian Commissioner Valentine, and tell him to do just what is right for us and help this Indian woman, Sun-a-was. All the Comanche Indians know

that Sun-a-was is a full-blood Comanche Indian woman and all the Comanches are anxious and willing for Sun-a-was to get allotment because she is one of our race and tribe and belongs to this country. Our Comanche chiefs, Quannah Parker and White Eagle, knows she is a full-blood Comanche woman. Sun-a-was came here from Mexico over two years ago and since then she got two payments with the Comanches and the first three payments she never got paid. Sun-a-was is entitled to our annuity payments and wants to get land just like her people, the Comanches, and have a home to stay on and settle down like us. Sun-a-was is tired of going from one place to another and she wants a home of her own and be done with going around like a wandering dog, got no land or home to stay on, but when given a land like her people, she will be made comfortable and happy."
