**THE BATH PREVENTS INJURY TO CEREALS**

Use of a lime bath for preventing injury to cereals in seed treatment is suggested by H. P. Baras, professor botany and plant pathology at the Oregon Agricultural college.  
In the Columbia basin region, Professor Baras, "the most desirable chemical to use for grain treatment for smut prevention is copper sulphate or blue stone, but extensive investigations at the experiment station have shown that this causes a large amount of injury to most lots of seed due to penetration of the copper sulphate through the small cracks which always occur in the seed coat over the germ, resulting from ordinary threshing.  
If a lime bath is used the poisonous effects of the copper are neutralized and the injury greatly reduced. Dipping the grain in the copper sulphate solution—one pound of blue stone to five gallons of water—seed is drained and plunged at once in the lime bath made by slaking one pound of lime in 10 gallons of water, and then spreading out to dry or planting as soon as possible. The lime bath is gradually weakened in neutralizing the copper and should be brought to normal again by occasional additions of strong lime, points out Professor Baras. A lime bath which has been long enough to give a slight green coat to the blade of a pocket knife has already lost its power of neutralizing the poisonous effect of blue stone and a new solution should be used.
