Then came the concerto, invented by Joralli, who employed the ordinary string quartet and the solo instrument. Wind instruments were later added, and finally the instrumental parts were doubled, and thus a real approach was made toward the symphony, the great tone epics of Haydn, Mozart and Beethoven. The musicians generally associated with this formative time are Gossec, Joeske, Vanhall and Bach, with Gossec in the van.—New York American.
