# The Brood Sow

For brooding she may be of a larger and coarser type than the boar, she possesses the other requisite qualifications. By all means should the dumpy China build be avoided, but this does not mean that the other extreme is any less objectional. She should be of a compact, firm build, and should possess enough size to be able to carry and support a large litter of pigs. To be a good brood sow means that she is a good suckler. The milking quality runs in strains of sows, as in cows, and no sow should be selected to breed from that is not of a deep milking family. Her disposition should be of the best, as you may enable one to save many a pig that an irritable sow would kill. She should be one of a litter of not less than eight and from a mature sire and dam. An animal that is in any way defective or delicate should be excluded from the breeding herd and in a sow especially is vigorous health and a good appetite necessary. With a litter of eight or ten pigs to feed, her digestive powers will be taxed to the utmost if the pigs are not to suffer. Bulletin 35, Miss. Exp. Station.

# California's Mustard Crop

"This country is now growing a larger part of the mustard put in England as well as this country," said a commercial man to a Washington Star reporter, "and California is raising the larger part of it. The mustard seed has just been harvested in California, and probably will run up to 10,000,000 pounds, or 1,000,000 pounds more than the crop of 1895. The seed is kept six months before being ground. The brown seed has the best flavor and greatest pungency, while the yellow produces the most oil. The English mustard-packers have made the yellow the most fashionable however, and as a result there are 10 pounds of yellow produced for every pound of the brown, though the brown is stronger and better in every respect. Probably one-half of the English mustard that is used in this country grew in California, though it was ground and packed in England. French mustard is the same as other mustard, the seed being soaked in vinegar, properly spiced, for 24 hours before it is ground."

# Poultry on the Farm

No one is better fitted for making poultry pay than the farmer. He can find no better market for cheap grain than poultry affords. But poultry on the farm must be commanded better. The farmer is indifferent, and the hens become lazy—and lazy hens are as unprofitable as a lazy farm hand. While there is always plenty of work on a farm during the winter, the income is nothing else but what has been earned during the summer. Why not increase the winter earnings by building snug houses, studying up the question of winter eggs and winter poultry, and devote your time to gradually building up to an industry that each year will enable you to gradually drop the harder work of farming, and that, too, with an increased income? Farmers should think well over these things, for to them more than to any one else, it means dollars in their pockets.—Southern Cultivator.
