## RAIN DELAYS MACADAMIZING OF NORTH WINTER STREET

Yesterday's rain put a stop to the macadamizing of North Winter street for the time being, but work will be resumed as soon as possible in order to complete the work before the winter has fully started in. Over two blocks of this highway has been built up in excellent shape, and within another week, providing the weather permits, the street will be mostly finished.

A good many of the people are under the impression that President Smart of the General Contracting company, has left for Portland and closed down the rock quarry south of the city, but the street rock is yet being prepared by the contracting company and this will continue until the Winter street improvement has been wholly completed. President Smart was on the point of shutting down the quarry some weeks ago for the winter and leave for Portland, but upon the urgent request of the property owners and those conducting the actual building of North Winter street, he took the matter up with the firm, and it was decided to furnish the rock.

North Winter street will be a great credit to the city when finished, and will be one of the main driveways during the next state fair.
