COOPER TRIAL ENDED TODAY

[United Press Leased Wire.] Nashville, Tenn., March 17.—Judge Hart today delivered one of the lengthiest charges to a jury in the history of the courts of Tennessee in the trial of Colonel Duncan Cooper, Robin Cooper, his son, and John D. Sharpe, charged with the murder of Senator Carmack. The instructions of the court number approximately 18,000 words, and covered every point raised between counsel during the progress of the case. To the most partisan spectator the charge could not be construed as favoring either side. The careful study and preparation of the charge was commented upon favorably by attorneys present. The general opinion before court convened was that the jury will disagree. In the course of his instructions Judge Hart said: "While the indictment contains one charge under the law, it embraces four felonies; murder in the first degree, murder in the second degree, voluntary manslaughter and involuntary manslaughter."

NINE CARS OF STUFF FOR SEATTLE FAIR [United Press Leased Wire.] Seattle, Wash., March 17.—The first shipment of exhibits for the Alaska-Yukon-Pacific exposition has arrived in Seattle. In the consignment, which filled nine cars, is part of the display of the Canadian government, which was exhibited at the Franco-British exposition in London last year. A large part of the display will be shown intact, but fresh material will be shipped from Canada when the Canadian building is ready for occupancy. The exhibit will show the resources of the country across the northern border. In forest products, grain, grasses, fruits and in minerals. Several of the exposition buildings have been ready for months to receive exhibits, and from now on every week will see the completion of new structures.

NEW TRANSCONTINENTAL READY FOR BUSINESS [United Press Leased Wire.] Tacoma, Wash., March 17.—The first train on the Chicago, Milwaukee & Puget Sound railroad to enter and leave the city over the road's own tracks, was a freight, which today took a train load of coal from the head of the bay to Seattle. The locomotive is a big ten-wheeler, with Engineer Hamilton at the throttle. If the present rate of progress in the work of track laying continues, it is estimated that in less than ten days regular freight train service will have been inaugurated on the new transcontinental line throughout the state of Washington.

THE "BUZZ SAW" CUTS RATHER DEEP Portland, Or., March 17.—Causing things to hum and buzz and tongues to wag, the "Buzz Saw," an anonymous publication which attacks everything in general about the Lincoln high school of this city, especially the fraternities, has created a big stir among the students of that institution. Copies of the two-leaflet pamphlet mysteriously appeared in the dead of night at each desk, so that they were discovered when school opened yesterday morning. They were greeted with murmurs of surprise, as the general tone of the pamphlet is directly against the aristocracy of the high school. While it contains many attacks along this line, the one that is the most severe is directed against the fraternities of the school. It charges that they run school politics to such an extent that "it is impossible for any student not identified with them to secure any position on an athletic or debating team; that they are corruptible and employ means that even lobbyists would not stoop to."

Under the caption, "Things Not Generally Known Around High," one article declares that lobbyists from the Lincoln high school were sent to Salem to prevent anti-fraternity legislation but failed. This allegation is followed by personal attacks and allusion to various members of the fraternity squad.
