TIME RIPE FOR SHIPPING NEWTOWNS

Sigbel & Day issue the following dated New York, Jan. 24: We now confirm our last report of the 17th and the foreign markets now stand as follows according to cables received.

Liverpool—L. Connolly & Co. advise that there is a good demand for Oregon Newtowns, while the Californians are neglected and quote Oregon fours at from 95ad to 10c; small 85ad to 95ad, while the Californians continue at about the same figures, say 4 tier 55ad to 65ad and small 4 to 5c.

London—M. Isaacs & Sons advise that their market is unchanged. Hamburg—Cables that there is a strong demand and their last quotations were from 10s to 13s.

TURNING OF COAL INTO GAS IS DEMONSTRATED

The new process of transforming coal into gas has proved successful, as shown by F. W. Topkin, formerly of the coal fields of Texas, at a demonstration in this city Wednesday.

A large crowd witnessed the demonstration, and it is likely that steps will be taken soon toward constructing a plant at the Sunnyside coal mine, and with the use of the refuse coal gas can be furnished for the valley with very little expense.

The apparatus was a home-made concern manufactured by Mr. Topkin by means of a blacksmith's fan and a couple of upright sheetiron pipes about fourteen inches in diameter and twenty-two inches high, connected up with pipes.

This was a crude machine, and of course a thorough demonstration could not be given, but the apparatus answered well the purpose, and a chorus of "ah's" passed through the crowd when the column of steam that was escaping from the second tank formed into a flame of fire when touched by a match.

BYBEE BRIDGE UNSAFE; WILL BE REPLACED SOON

E. G. Perham has filed a report with the county court covering the condition of the Bybee bridge, in which it is declared that the structure which has spanned the Rogue near Table Rock for 28 years, is unsafe. Temporary repairs are to be made at once and within a comparatively short time a new bridge will be constructed in its stead.

KELLY ISSUES POISON WARNING

Prosecuting Attorney E. E. Kelly issued a warning Wednesday afternoon to the ranchers of the Willow Springs district, who announced that they had declared war on digger squirrels and planned to exterminate them by spreading poisoned wheat.

Mr. Kelly sent the following letter to the Willow Springs range: "My attention was called to a publish article on the 29 instant, in which your organization is about to commence a war of extermination upon the ground squirrel.

"I need not call your attention, at this time, to the bird laws of this state providing penalties for the killing of certain protected birds, as I feel certain that your most law abiding organization will not violate any of these laws, and that the song birds and game birds will not suffer by reason of your campaign against the ground squirrel."
