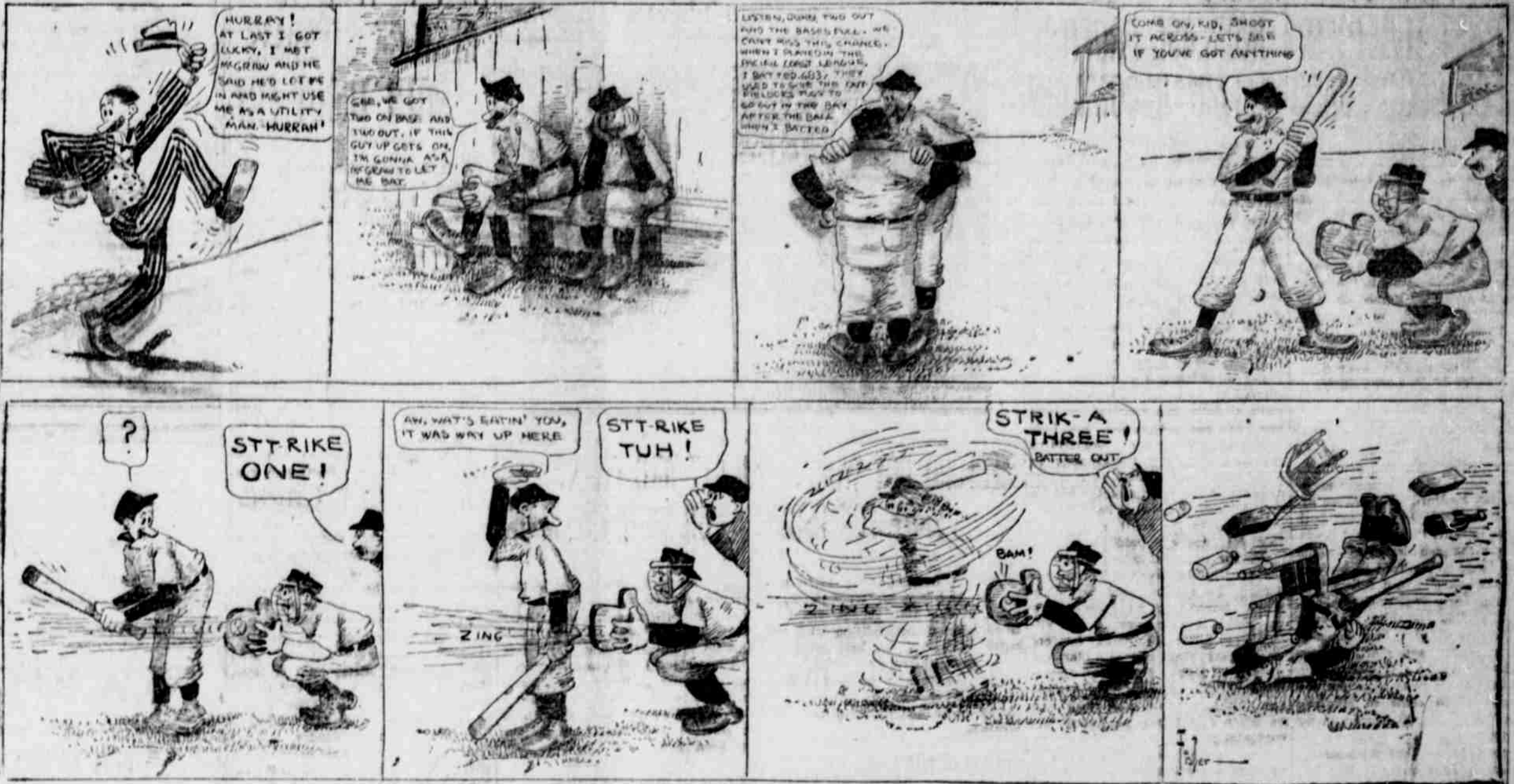
The City of Medford doth ordain as follows: Section 1. The mayor and recorder of the City of Medford, Oregon, are hereby authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of said city, with Schell & Schell, in the following form, and said act by said mayor and recorder is hereby expressly ratified, authorized and confirmed.

Section 2. The contractor hereby agrees to furnish a bond for the faithful performance of this contract, to be approved by the mayor of said city, for the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), guaranteeing in proper form the faithful performance of this contract and further indemnifying the City of Medford against any claims or liens for labor, work or material on account of sub-contractors, material men, laborers, and mechanics, furnishing labor or material on this contract.

Section 3. The contractor hereby agrees to furnish a bond for the faithful performance of this contract, to be approved by the mayor of said city, for the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), guaranteeing in proper form the faithful performance of this contract and further indemnifying the City of Medford against any claims or liens for labor, work or material on account of sub-contractors, material men, laborers, and mechanics, furnishing labor or material on this contract.

Section 4. The contractor hereby agrees to furnish a bond for the faithful performance of this contract, to be approved by the mayor of said city, for the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), guaranteeing in proper form the faithful performance of this contract and further indemnifying the City of Medford against any claims or liens for labor, work or material on account of sub-contractors, material men, laborers, and mechanics, furnishing labor or material on this contract.

In consideration whereof, the city agrees to pay the contractor for such work and materials at the following prices, namely: Paving including the surface finishing, curbs and foundation, per square yard \$1.15

Excavating, per cu. yard .45 Concrete curb, straight, per lin. foot .35 Concrete curb, curved, per lin. foot .45

Concrete curb and gutter, per lin. foot .45 Concrete curb and gutter, armored curved, per lin. foot .88 Drain pipe, 6 inch, per lin. foot .50

Drain pipe, 8 inch, per lin. foot .60 Catch basin, per each 18.00 Concrete curb, curved, armored, per lin. foot .65

The contractor shall look for payment only to the street and road fund and will not require the City of Medford by any legal process or otherwise, to pay the same out of any other fund.

Upon the completion of the improvement upon each street, according to the contract, the city shall forthwith accept the work done and performed by the contractor and this contract shall be, to the extent of the work done and performed, considered consummated.

The contractor shall receive warrants to the amount of eighty (80) per cent. of the work completed each month and warrants for the balance of twenty (20) per cent. shall be issued upon the completion of the contract.
