FINNISH FEARS. From Finland comes the news that the czar is preparing to abolish the liberties of that country, where for eighty years the spectacle has been presented of a free state subject to the most despotic power in the civilized world.

The czar is the grand duke of Finland and head of the state. He appoints for life the members of the senate, or upper house, whose duties are those of a high court of justice and an administrative council, legislative authority being vested in the diet, an elective body in which all classes of the population are represented and which is called together every five years.

The Russian people who, notwithstanding all obstructions and restrictions, are every day growing in intelligence, have before them the remarkable example of a conquered province enjoying a constitutional government, while they themselves are absolutely denied any voice in their own affairs.

Another motive for Russian jealousy is the close relationship between the ruling classes of Finland and Sweden. Swedish is the official language of Finland.

There is reason to believe that the Russian government is encouraging the emigration of Swedish Finns, with a view to getting rid of an element that is a menace to Russian designs.

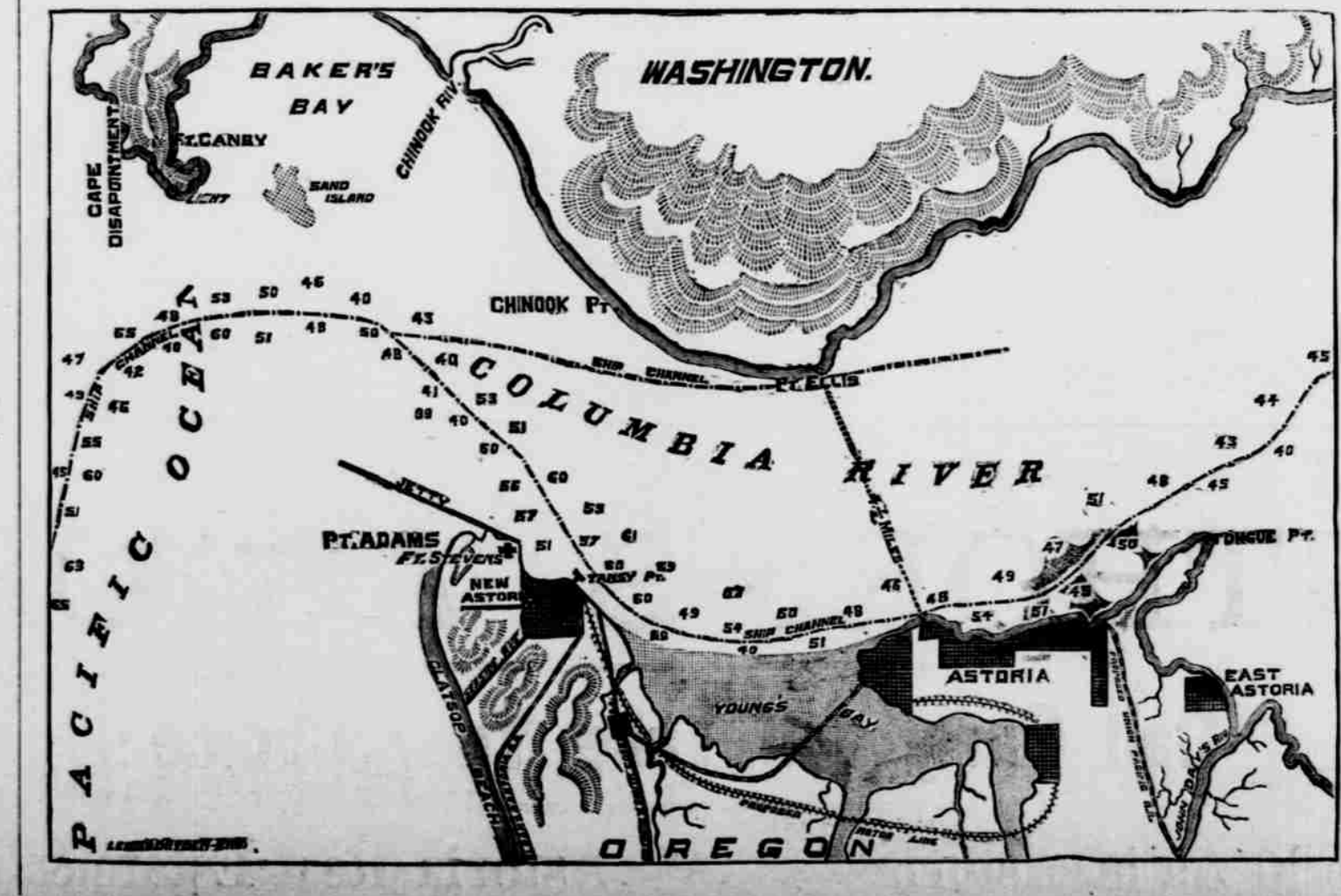
