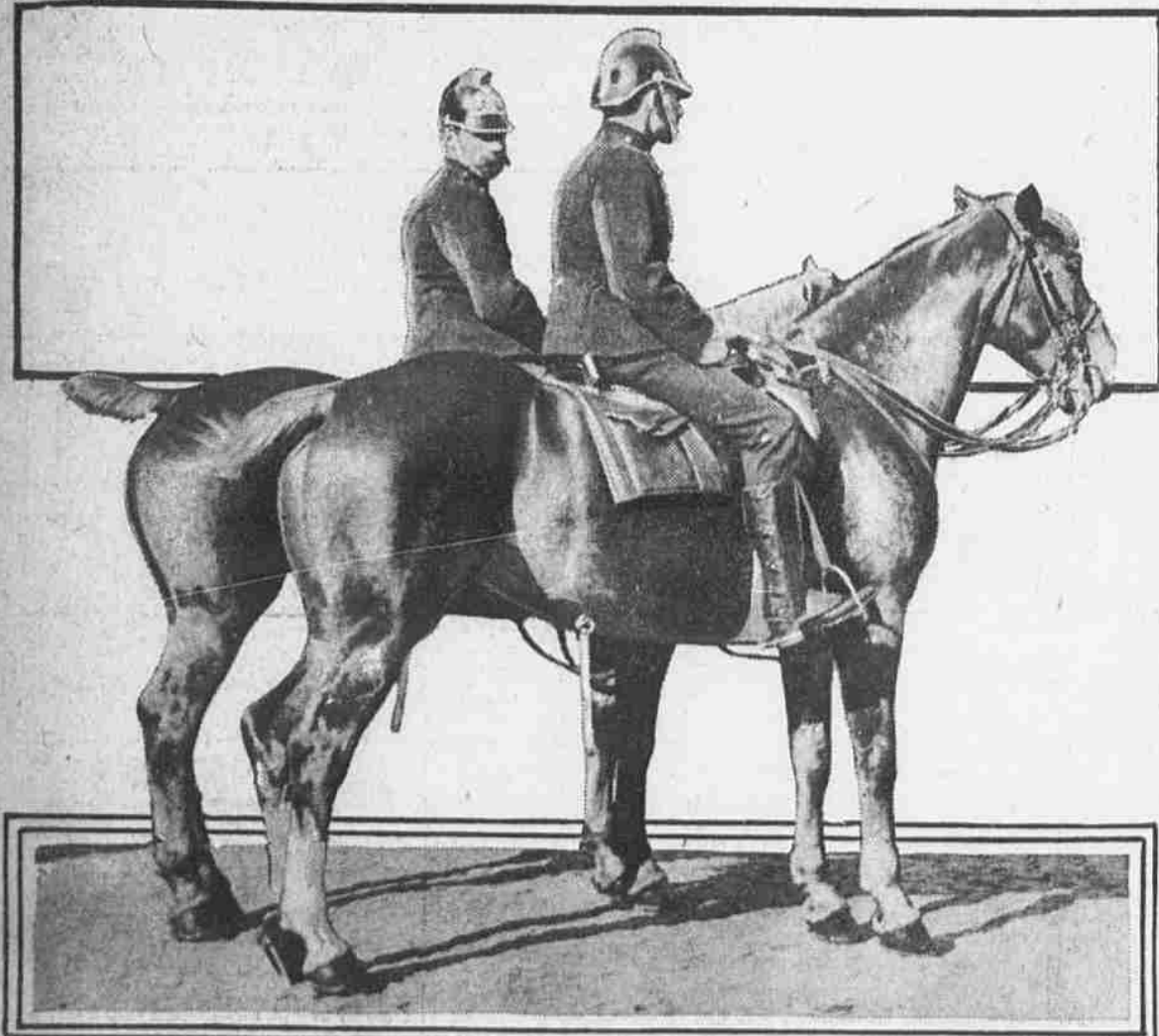
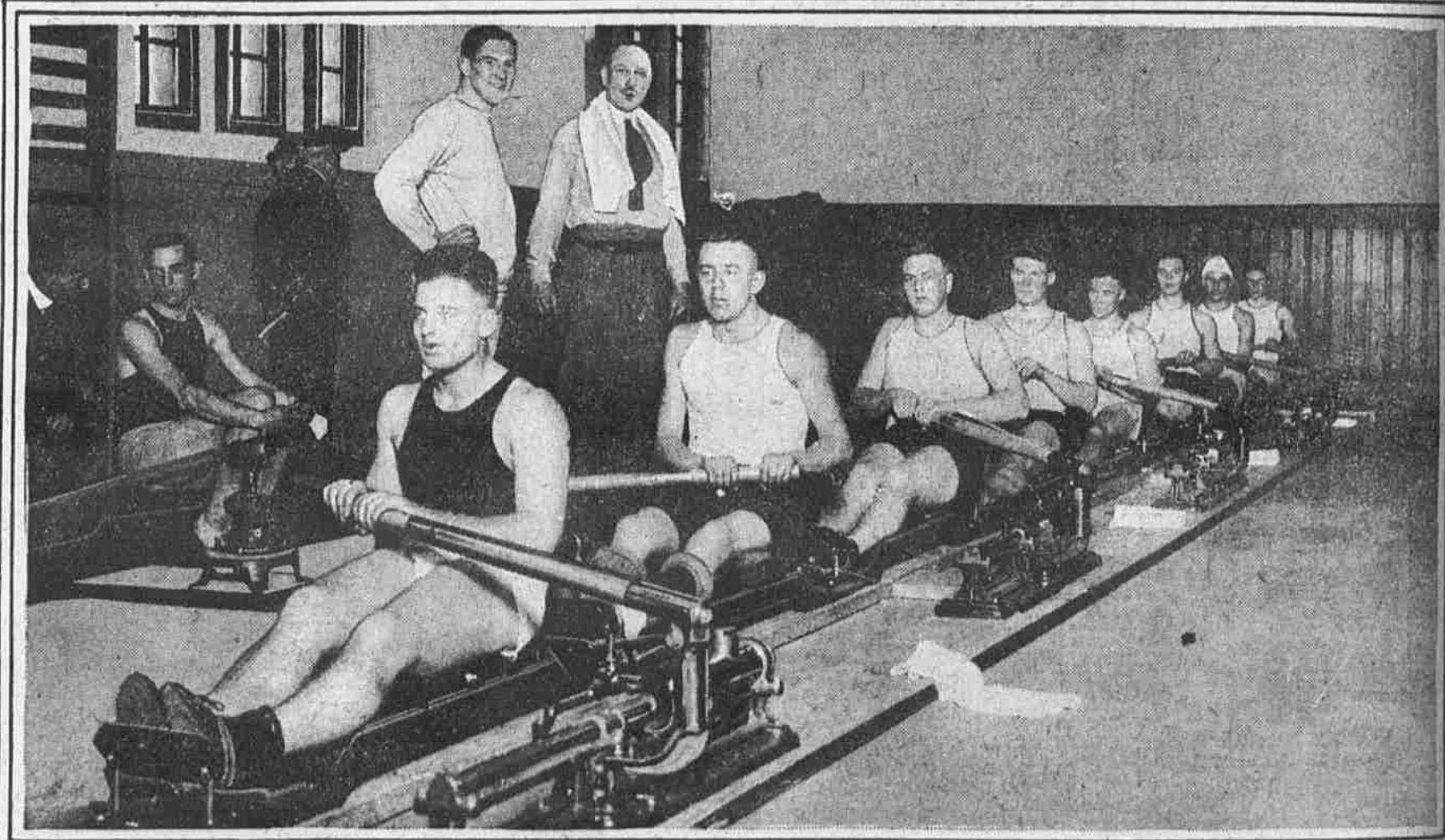

Queen Wilhelmina's army of 350,000 is one of the best equipped in Europe. The cavalry branch raises and trains its own horses.

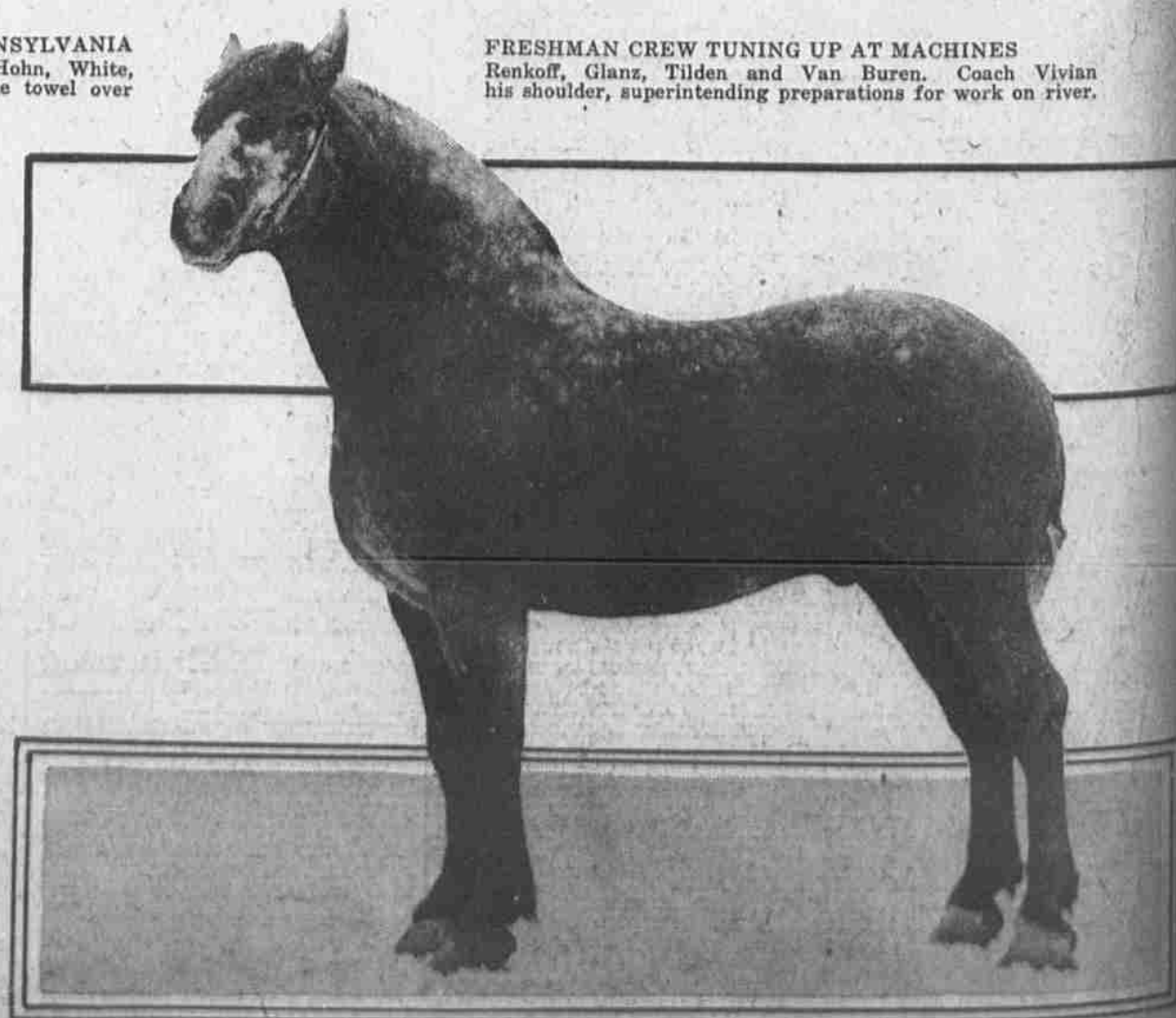
