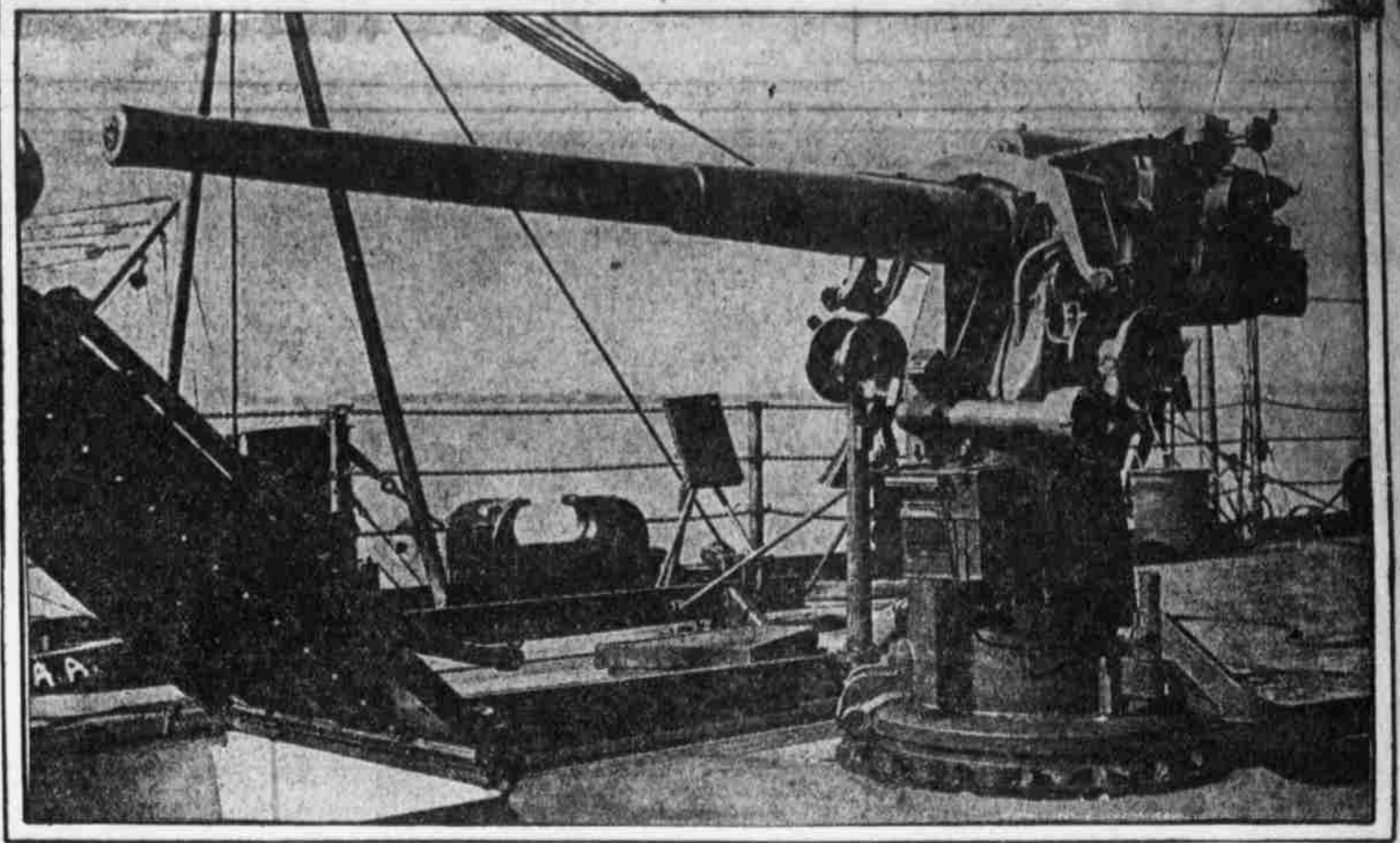


PHILADELPHIA CONTRIBUTES LION'S SHARE TO THE PICTURESQUE NEWS OF THE DAY

While equipped with latest devices to destroy enemy submarines, the men behind the anti-aircraft gun on the battleship Oklahoma know how to use that weapon.

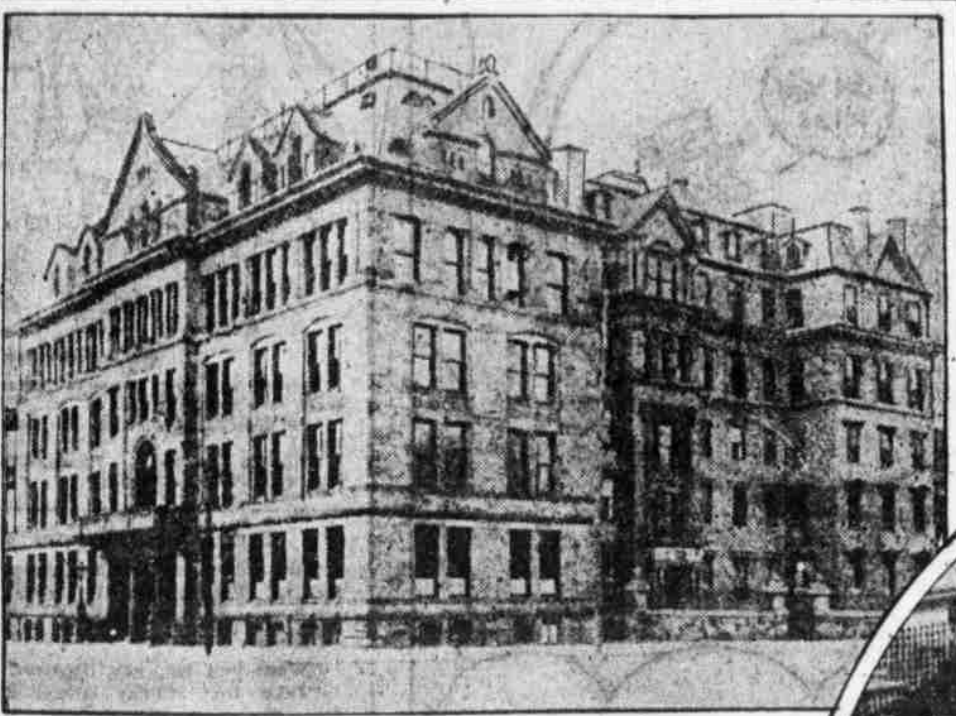

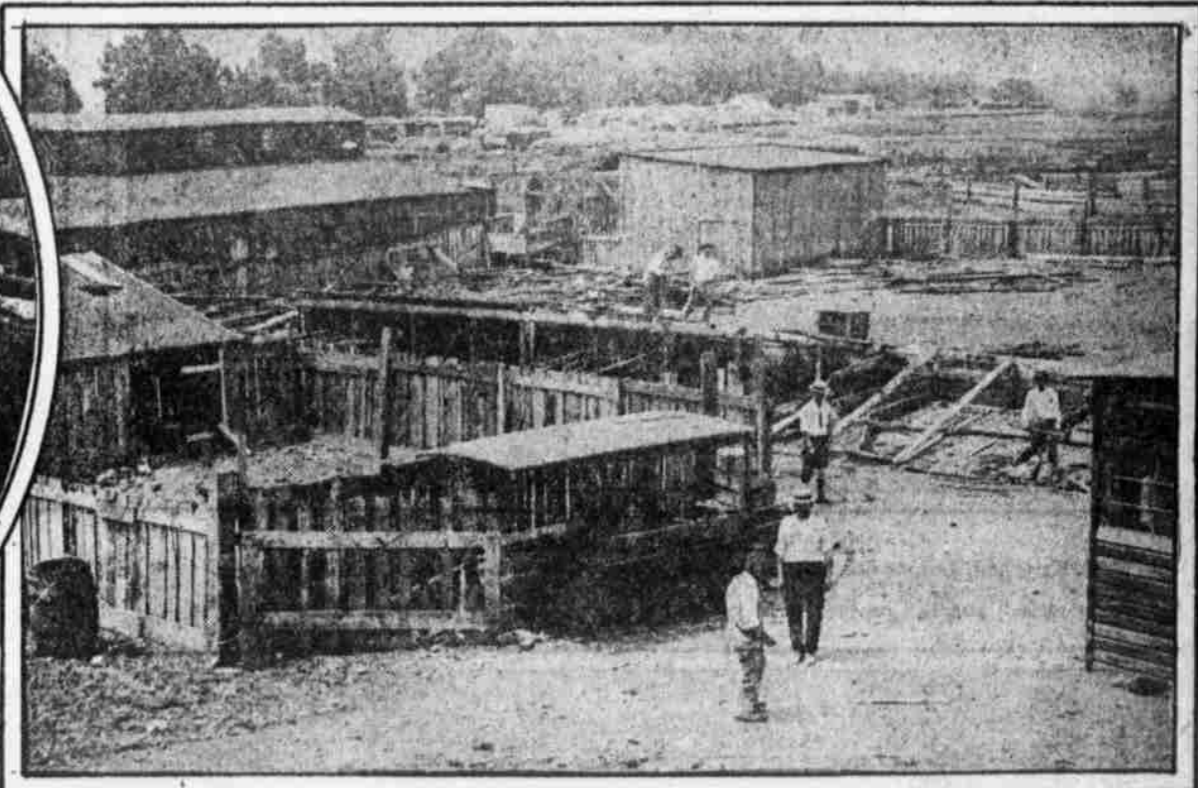
WORK AND PLAY COMBINE IN NEW CURRICULUM

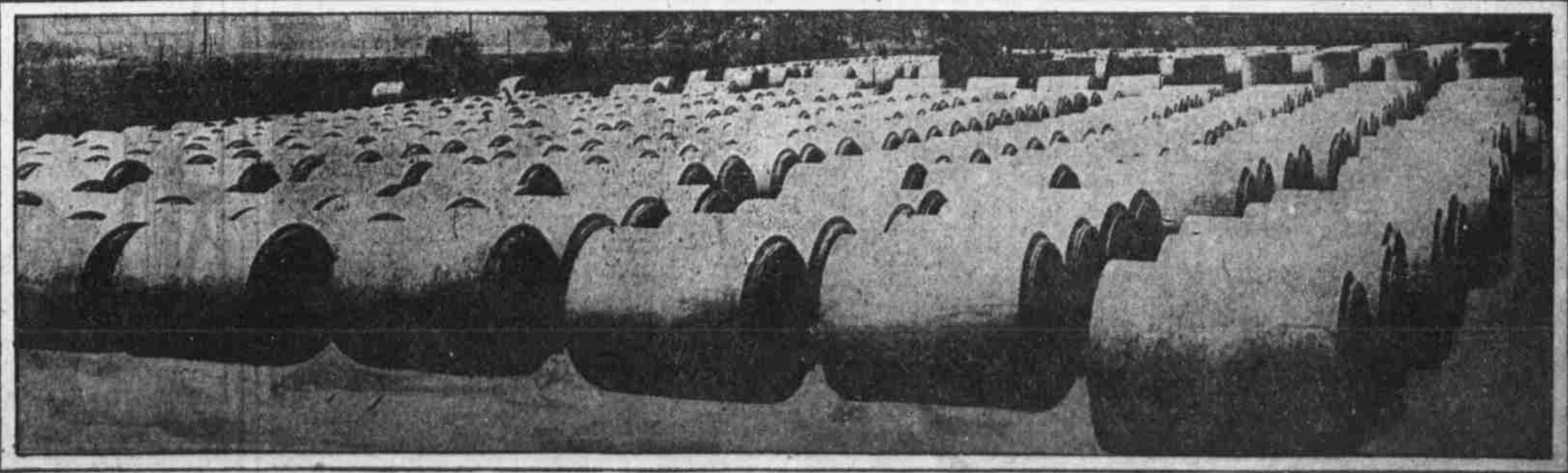
BOOKKEEPING AND BOX SCORE ARE BUT FIFTEEN MINUTES APART
