Letters of marque and reprisal, as they were called, were first issued in the time of Edward I. to give leave to retaliate beyond the marches or limits of a country for wrongs suffered at the hands of a power nominally at peace. In this first instance they were aimed at Portugal. About a hundred years later two Hanse towns in Mecklenburg, wishing to relieve their prince, who was beleaguered in Stockholm, issued letters of marque-thieves' letters, as the sufferers called them—to all the rascals of the Baltic, authorizing them to victual the besieged city. This done, they turned them-

selves into a confederacy of sea robbers known as Victualing brothers, or St. Vitallus' brothers, and rendered the Scandinavian seas unsafe for half a century.

YALE WANTS A LEAVENWORTH.

Scholarship For Some One of That Name Goes a Begging.

New Haven, Conn., Nov. 14.—Just before Secretary Anson Phelps Stokes, Jr., of the Yale corporation called for Europe he caused to be advertised the fact that the Leavenworth scholarship at Yale, yielding annually \$300, is vacant. Secretary Stokes stated that this scholarship was open to competition to all young men of the name of Leavenworth.

This is probably the first instance wherein Yale university has had a scholarship on its hands that went begging. It is the first time that there has not been some one in the university by the name of Leavenworth to make a go for this scholarship. The last regular recipient was John Wallace Leavenworth, who graduated from the Sheffield Scientific school last year.

The Leavenworth fund provides an annuity of \$300. This can be materially increased if the president of the university desires to increase it. The man who gets the Leavenworth scholarship must be of good character and promise, the president to determine these qualities. This gift was left to Yale by the late Elias W. Leavenworth of Syracuse, N. Y., Yale, '24, and was received in 1882 for the endowment of a Leavenworth professorship. This fund now amounts to over \$20,000.

Denial by Kenyon College President. Columbus, O., Nov. 14.—President W. E. Pierce of Kenyon college was in Columbus conferring with Attorney T. P. Linn and Rev. John Hewitt, both trustees of the institution, concerning the tragic death of Stuart Pierson and accusations which have been abundantly made. In a stated statement issued by President Pierce he emphatically denies what he terms "perversions of the truth which have got abroad" and absolves the students from any charge of misdoing, and says there has been no effort by the college authorities to stifle investigation.
