## GREENVILLE SCHOOL WINS TRACK MEET.

Central Gets Second Place; Pickens Wins Fourth.

For the second consecutive year the Greenville high school last Saturday won first place in the annual track meet of the Piedmont Inter-High School Oratorical and Athletic Association which was held on nearby Furman, and attended by a large number. Eighty-athletes were entered in the meet.

Greenville's team scoring a total of 24 points. Coming second was Central, with 17 points, while Anderson made third place with 12 points. Pickens was fourth with 8 points. Under the rules of the organization, the winning team next year will be the team which was second this year.
