

CONSUMERS CAN BUY TWO TONS

Fuel Administrator Williams Amends Emergency Rules. Nineteen Cars Arrive.

Hamilton County Fuel Administrator R. H. Williams has amended the emergency coal rules which he issued Saturday, Jan. 5.

The regulations as amended state that the dealers are no longer required to admit peddlers and other customers to their yards. Mr. Williams, also, in the second section of the amendment, revokes the order allowing no dealer to sell over one-half ton of lump coal or more than one ton of run-of-the-mine to a customer.

The amended coal regulations, effective Jan. 9, 1918, are as follows: "The emergency rules made on Saturday, Jan. 5, are amended as follows: "1. Dealers are no longer required to admit peddlers or other customers to their yards...
