Memorial of Radical Congressmen Praying Congress to Restore the State Government of Tennessee.

THE MEMORIAL. The undersigned, members of the Senate and House of Representatives, representing the State of Tennessee...

1. That men were allowed to vote and did vote therein, who were not registered according to the Constitution and laws...

2. That men ineligible under the Constitution and laws were permitted to vote, and did vote in said election.

3. That youths under the age of twenty-one years, in violation of said laws, were permitted to vote in said election.

4. That false and fraudulent votes were counted as having been cast in various counties in excess of the legal voters therein.

5. That in nearly all the counties of the State, threats, intimidation and unjust influence were used to deter, and which did deter large numbers of good citizens and legal voters from exercising their rights at such election.

6. That persons not eligible or qualified to hold any office under the Constitution and laws of said State and the United States, did act as judges of said election in many counties of said State.

7. That the illegal votes so cast were of such great numbers as to be in excess of the majority by which said election was determined in a majority of the counties...
