FRENCH USING CAVALRY TO PURSUE GERMANS

PARIS, Nov. 7.—Along the entire French front the pursuit of the retreating Germans was taken up again this morning, according to today's war office announcement.

GERMANS TELL BELGIANS THEY ARE LEAVING GHENT

ON THE BATTLE FRONT IN BELGIUM, Nov. 7.—A wireless dispatch was received at the headquarters of Gen. Beaurains from the Germans, saying they had decided to abandon Ghent and asking the Belgians not to fire on the suburbs of the town where white flags were raised.

BRITISH NOW CLOSE TO BORDERS OF BELGIUM

LONDON, Nov. 7.—British forces are continuing their progress along the Franco-Belgian battle line. Northeast of Valenciennes, according to Field Marshal Haig's report today, they have reached the outskirts of Quevrain and Crepin, close to the Belgian border.

FRENCH ATTACKS NET BIGGEST GAIN OF WAR

PARIS, Nov. 7.—The operations by the French yesterday netted one of the greatest gains in the war. They advanced more than six miles at various points. The important towns of Verwin, Montecourt and Les Evrais were captured.

1,000,000 AUSTRIANS ARE PRISONERS OF ITALIANS

ITALIAN HEADQUARTERS IN EASTERN ITALY, Nov. 7.—(By the Associated Press.)—The Italian army is entering the last border of its great victory. The value of the captured material will eventually reach \$5,000,000,000, it is estimated. It now includes 200,000 horses and 4,000 guns.

HAIG'S NIGHT STATEMENT TELLS OF NEW ADVANCE

LONDON, Nov. 7.—(By the Associated Press.)—The British are continuing their advances east of Morlancourt, according to Field Marshal Haig's report last night from headquarters, and have occupied numerous villages and an important railway junction at Aulnoy.

POILUS BOUND ONWARD PRESSING CLOSE ON HUN

WITH THE FRENCH ARMIES IN FRANCE, Nov. 7.—(By the Associated Press.)—The French armies made an other forward bound yesterday of from five to seven miles, all along their front, from the English Channel to the Meuse, pressing close upon the retreating Huns, who are in full retreat.

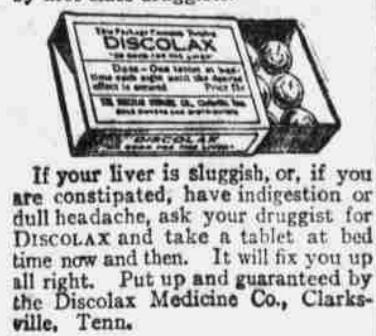
