To the Delegates of the Cotton Congress Now is the time for the Southern farmers to diversify. Do not plan a temporary relief which you expect to serve only in emergencies such as exist at present. Do not substitute for cotton without a definite plan for the future. At a recent conference in Memphis, attended by a number of government experts and representative heads of agricultural colleges, these experts advised that the farmer of the South make permanent cotton acreage reductions. "Substitution or diversification," said one noted editor, "must not be for a season or two, but must be the well-defined policy of the Southern farmer for the future guarantee of independence and prosperity in the South. So reduce your cotton acreage permanently—add live stock, corn, peas, potatoes, fruits—make every plantation more nearly self sustaining, whether the year is good or bad." The markets here are being daily improved. The freight rates are favorable to Memphis. Grow the various products for the Memphis market.
