### DEMOCRATS MADE GAINS

#### Increase in the Number of Congressmen

While Mr. Bryan was defeated, the Democrats achieved victories in several of the States that are sure to bring fruit in the immediate years to come. Here are some of them:

Colorado elected the entire State ticket, and the Legislature, which will select Hughes, Democrat, to succeed Teller in the U. S. Senate.

In Nebraska the entire State ticket, a majority of the Legislature, and several new Congressmen were elected.

In Iowa Republicans were defeated for Congress, among them being the veteran Pete Hepburn, one of the leaders of his party.

In Minnesota John Johnson was re-elected for the third term, with Taft getting an 80,000 majority. This breaks a precedent, for no man has ever before held the Governorship three terms.

In Indiana the entire State ticket was elected, a Democratic Legislature that will probably choose John W. Kern to succeed Senator Hemmenway, and eleven out of thirteen Congressmen.

In North Dakota Governor Burke, Democrat, was re-elected.

All through the West and Middle West there was a large gain in the Democratic vote.

So far as the doubtful States are concerned in the Presidential race, the latest returns to the Commercial Appeal indicate that Taft has carried Maryland by less than 150 votes, West Virginia probably three thousand, Indiana by ten thousand, Ohio by eighty thousand, Missouri in doubt, and Montana by three thousand.

Congress will show a number of changes, but the relative strength of the two parties in both Houses remains about the same. The Senate retained members from the House, most one in each State, in Georgia, Carolina, and Kentucky. In Kentucky, in

Marshall in Indiana.

On the other hand, while Bryan carried Missouri by a safe margin, the election of Herbert S. Hadley, the Republican candidate for Governor, was indicated.

At 11 o'clock it was certain that the Republicans will control the next House of Representatives.

William Howard Taft of Ohio, Republican, has been elected President of the United States, and James Schoolcraft Sherman of New York, has been chosen Vice President. This is the outcome of one of the most remarkable political campaigns in the history of the republic.

William Jennings Bryan of Nebraska, the Democratic candidate, went down in the third defeat of his life's ambition to occupy the White House. Returns received up to 8 a. m. to-day indicated that Mr. Taft would have at least 298 electoral votes, and as the details come in increasing fullness from the West, it began to look as if the figures might reach the 325 mark claimed as assured to him in the ante-election forecast of Chairman Hitchcock of the Republican National Committee, or possibly even approach the 336 achieved in 1904 by Mr. Roosevelt. The number necessary to a choice is 242.

#### IN GREATER CITY.

One of the results surpassing the most sanguine hopes of most Republicans was Mr. Taft's carrying the greater City of New York by a plurality which early to-day, with 94 out of 1,633 districts missing, footed 9,378. Furthermore his plurality in New York State will be approximately 189,334, exceeding by nearly 14,000 Roosevelt's plurality of 1904.
