(Herald Special.)

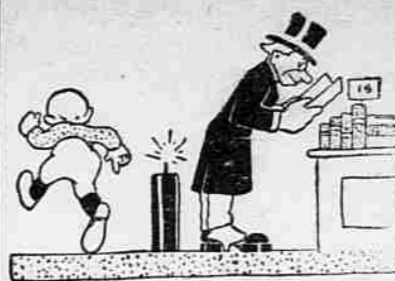

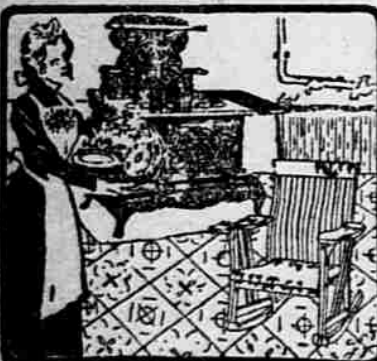
