

Salinas, Cal., July 12.-The second section of the Coast Line Southern Pacific passenger train was ditched near Getz this morning, and six persons are known to be dead and scores of others injured. The message boldly declares that Germany's recognition of Madriz is a matter that concerns only Germany and Nicaragua.

The first message by the German foreign office issued today, authorized the statement that Emperor William's letter to Madriz of Nicaragua was only the customary diplomatic acknowledgement of the emperor's intimation that Madriz had assumed the office of president, and cannot understand the fuss raised unless it is deliberately stirred up for the purpose of creating a dissension between Germany and the United States.


